



## Code of Conduct for students of the Erasmus+ Project Connecting with Nature

The following guidelines will help making your exchange a full success:

- If I don't know or understand what I am supposed to do I will ask someone in charge.
- If any problems arise and if I don't know how to behave I will ask an accompanying teacher who will be glad to help.
- I take part in all common activities and in the lessons which were scheduled. They are part of the project.
- I respect the rules, laws and conventions and habits of my host country. I follow the instructions of my accompanying teachers, my host parents and my host school.
- I limit the use of my smartphone during the exchange. I switch off or put away my phone during the lessons, activities, visits and during common meals and activities with my host family. Exception: I take pictures. If I publish pictures, voices or videos I need the permission of the people in them.
- In the interest of the group I keep schedules of my teachers and my host family.
- To make sure that my teachers and host family don't worry unnecessarily I ensure that they always know about my whereabouts. I do not leave my family or group without permission.
- Security first! I stay in groups of at least two students when I am in the exchange country.
- I am aware that I am a representative of my school, my region and my country when I am abroad. Therefore I always act responsibly and respectfully.

I solemnly declare that I will respect the above listed rules and accept that I might be excluded from the project and sent home on my own expense if I do violate these rules.
