First topic

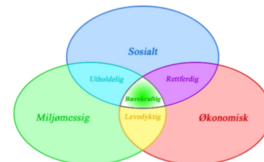

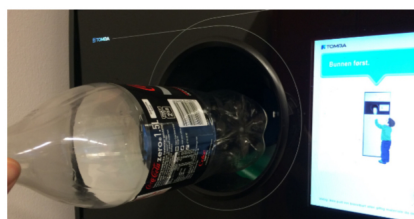


Secondly we discussed different types of environmental challenges we face in today's society. Plastic emerged as one of the main challenges.

- Is it possible to recycle the plastic to become something useful? In that case, what?

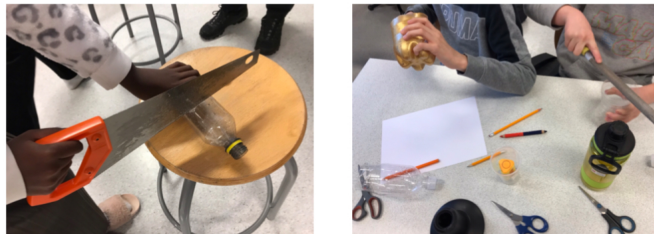




Thirdly we discussed what we could recycle the plastic to become which is also something useful before we looked at some inspirational pictures of what we could make.
