

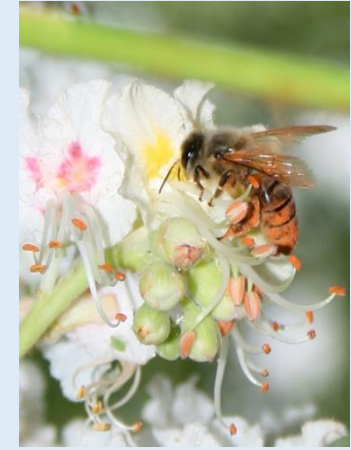

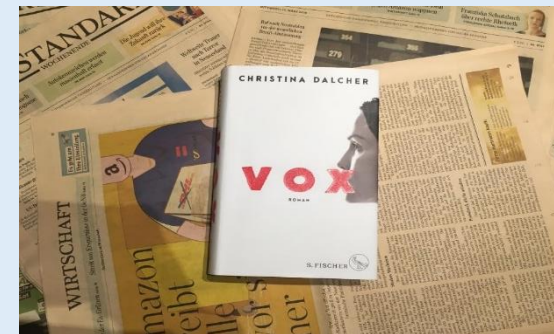

A bird flies, the sun shines, a sweet surprise

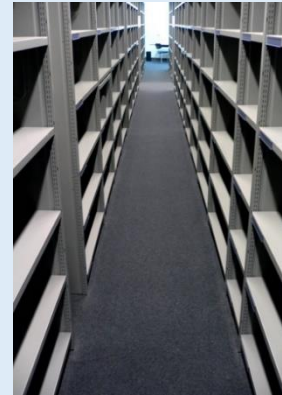


The sky as blue as it can be

She would write poems to her friends on their birthdays with messages to her middle school crush.

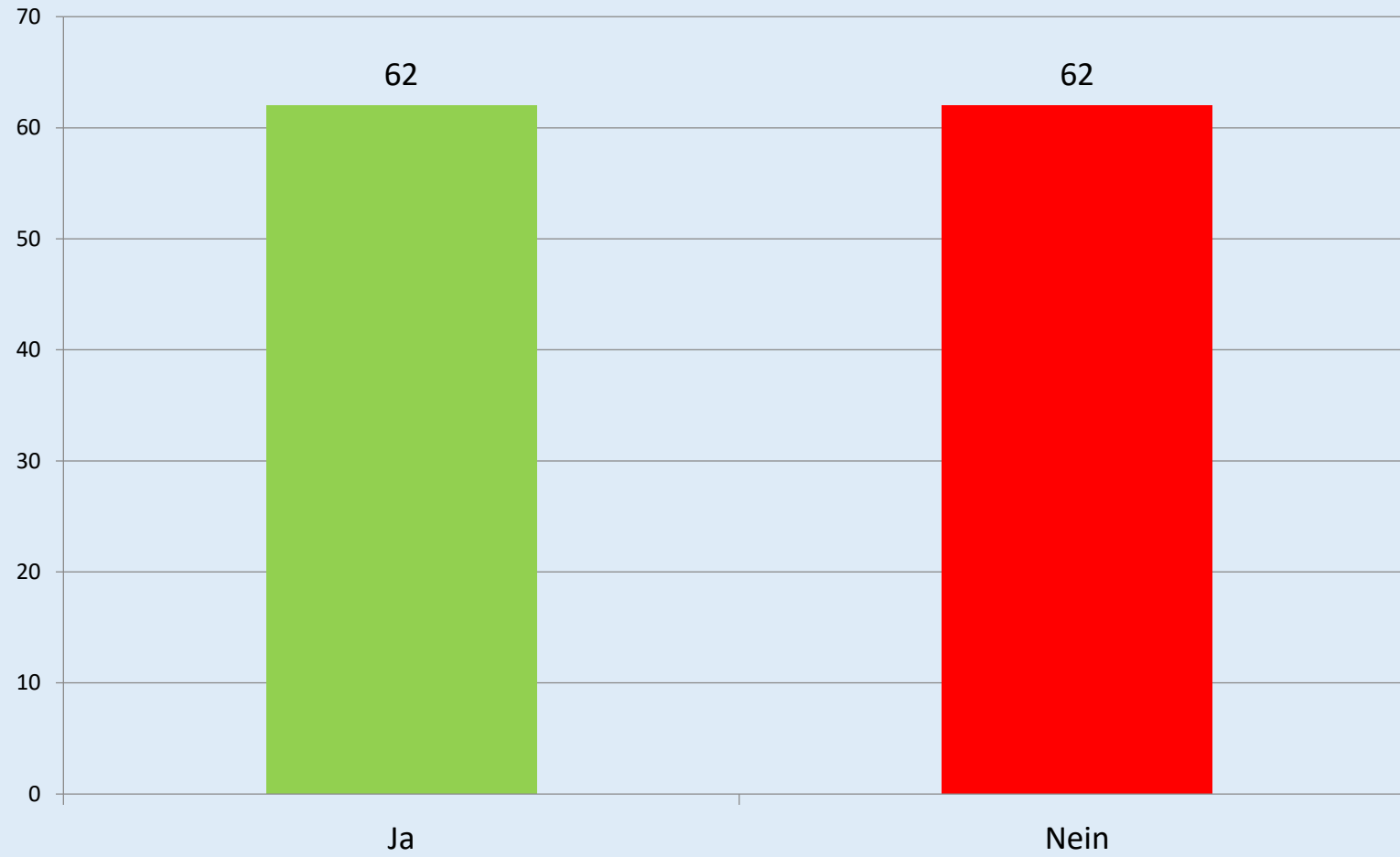

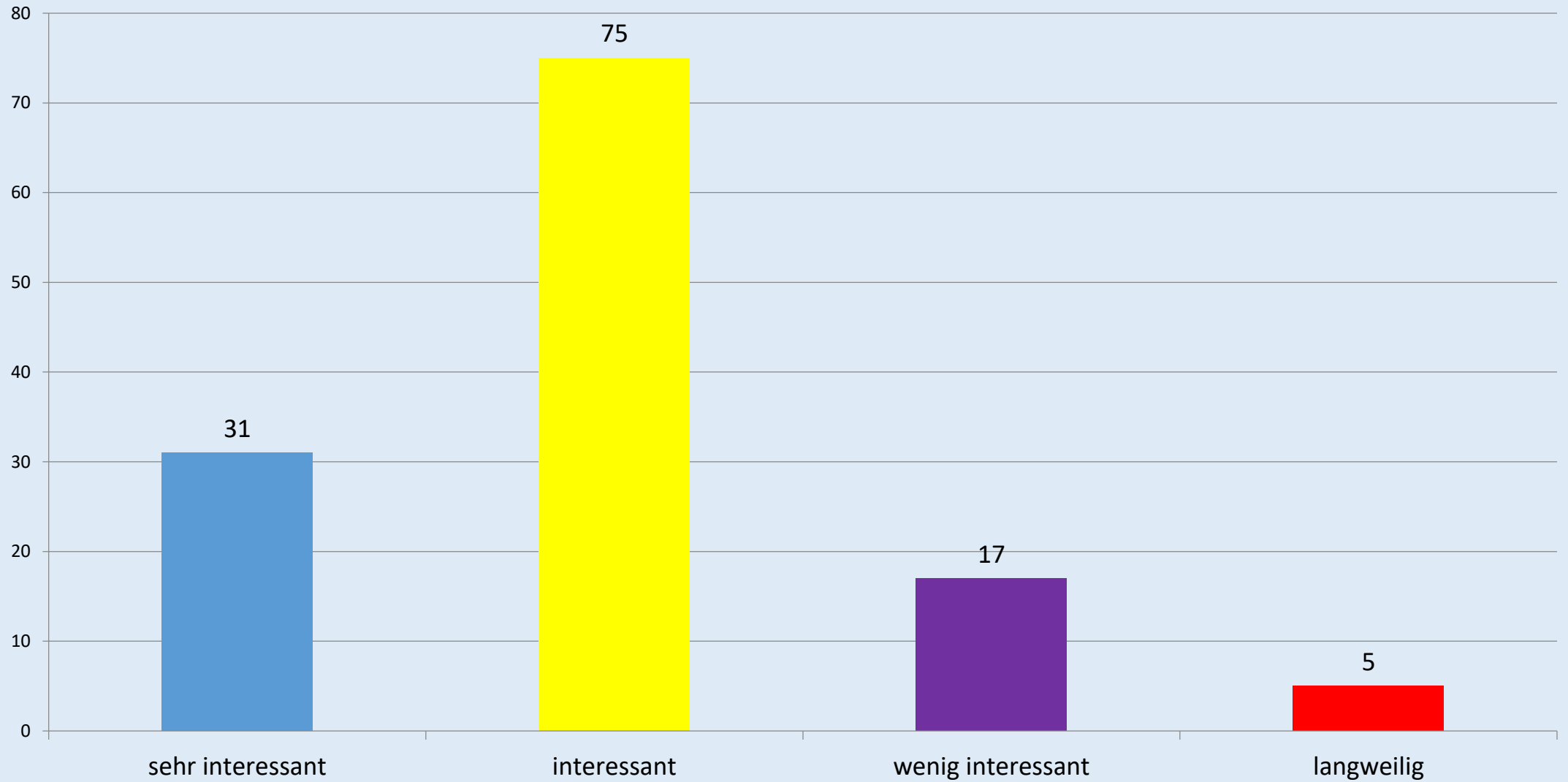
