Social behaviour of a group of people

- + knowledge

Communication

The process of sending and receiving information (by using messages).

Types of context ***

- + Low-context: what we say is what we mean 🛸
- + High-context: what we say + non verbal and
 - *contextual* clues composes what we mean 😥

Dimensions of culture

- Individualism / Collectivism *
- Power Distance *
- Masculinity / Femininity
- Uncertainty Avoidance
- Long-term / Short-term orientation
- Indulge / Restraint

Individualism / Collectivism (- -)
Preference of individual thoughts over
the collective's will

Power Distance:

Preference of equity or subordination between institution and people

Generally:

Individualism <=> Low power distance
Collectivism <=> High power distance

Examples:

- Russia, South America, South-East Asia...
- North America, Australia, Europe...
