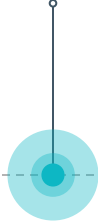

## Why Venezuela?

Because in Venezuela there is a government crisis and because of this great problem the country has fallen into a deep economic crisis. To give you an idea, the monthly budget of a Venezuelan is 300,000 Bolivares that are equivalent to 3.5 Euros.

In addition, the government has a huge blockade of trade with other countries, so food and medicine are barely arriving.
