FRANTIŠEK HRUBÍN

Frantisek Hrubín was born into the family of a builder at Prague.

His family lived in Lešany near Prague during World War I, and Hrubín visited his home village throughout his life.

He studied at a grammar school in Prague studying law and philosophy at Charles University, but he did not graduate.



He got married in 1939 and had a daughter and a son.

Romance for Flugelhorn

In 1961, he published a poem in book form titled *Romance for Flugelhorn*. This poem eventually became his most popular work. It tells the story of a young boy who falls in love with a girl from a carousel. It is considered one of the most famous poems of the Czech literature.

After World War II he worked briefly at the Ministry of Propaganda and became a freelance writer in 1946.

He died in České Budějovice and is buried at the Vyšehrad cemetery.
