### Presentation of Loureiro

Loureiro is a Portuguese semi-urban parish of the county of Oliveira de Azeméis and Metropolitan Area of Porto, with 17,13 km<sup>2</sup> of area and 3 531 inhabitants (2011). Its population density is of 206,1 hab / km<sup>2</sup>.

It borders the following parishes: UJ, Travanca, Pinheiro da Bemposta, S. Martinho da Gândara, Madal, Beduído and Avanca, the last two outside the municipality of Oliveira de Azeméis.
