

Customs

There are many customs in Cyprus especially at Christmas when friends and relatives gather at each other's houses and enjoy food and sweets such as melomakarona and kourambiedes.

On New Year's Day people put a coin in Vasilopita and whoever finds it has a lucky year ahead.

They also throw a leaf from an olive tree in the fireplace to find out if the person we are interested in is in love with us.

Some national dishes in Cyprus are:

- Sheftalia: grilled sausage made of ground meat.
- Halloumi: Cheese made from either sheep's or Cow's milk which tastes especially good when fried. You Can only find this Cheese in Cyprus.
- ✤ Koupepia (Vine leaves stuffed with minced meat and rice).
- * Talattouri (Tzatziki): yogurt prepared with Cucumber and peppermint.
