Ukrainian Varenyky stuffed with meat, served with fried onions and sour cream



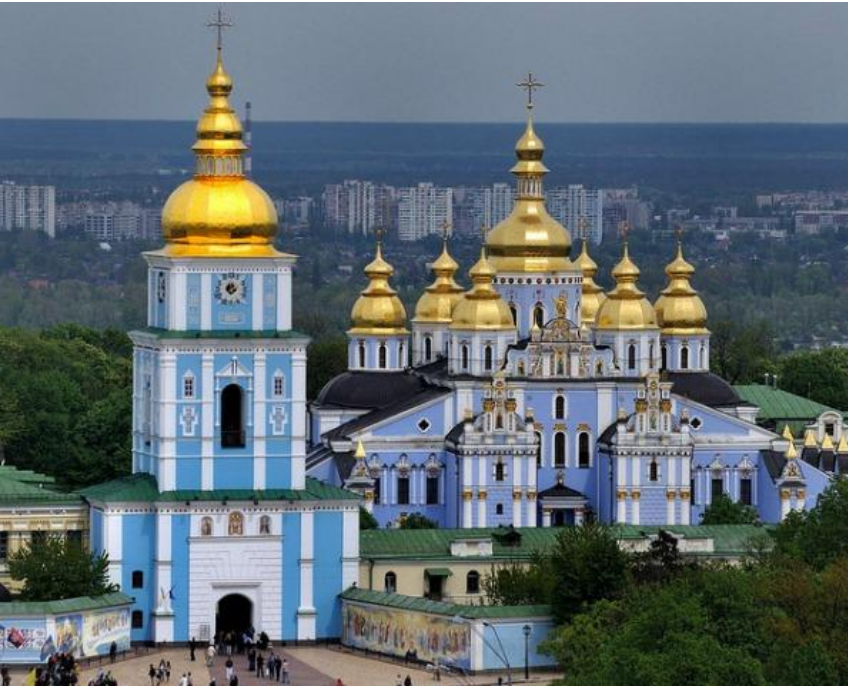
- ❖ Borsch (a traditional soup, made out of beet root and up to 20 other ingredients)

- ❖ Famous specialties named after the capital city Kiev such as chicken kiev and the dessert Kiev cake.

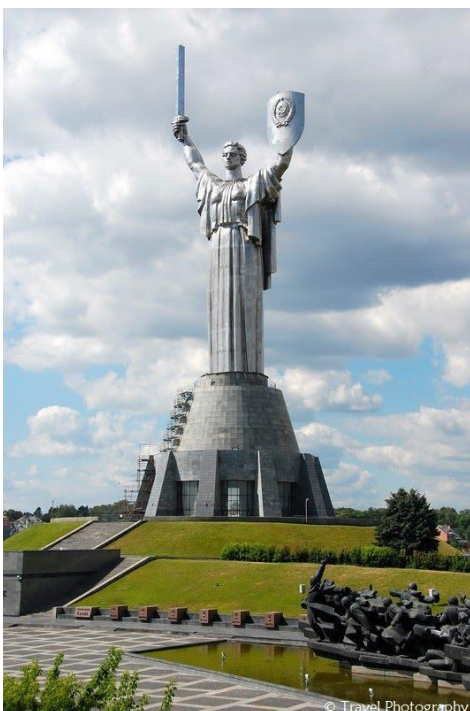
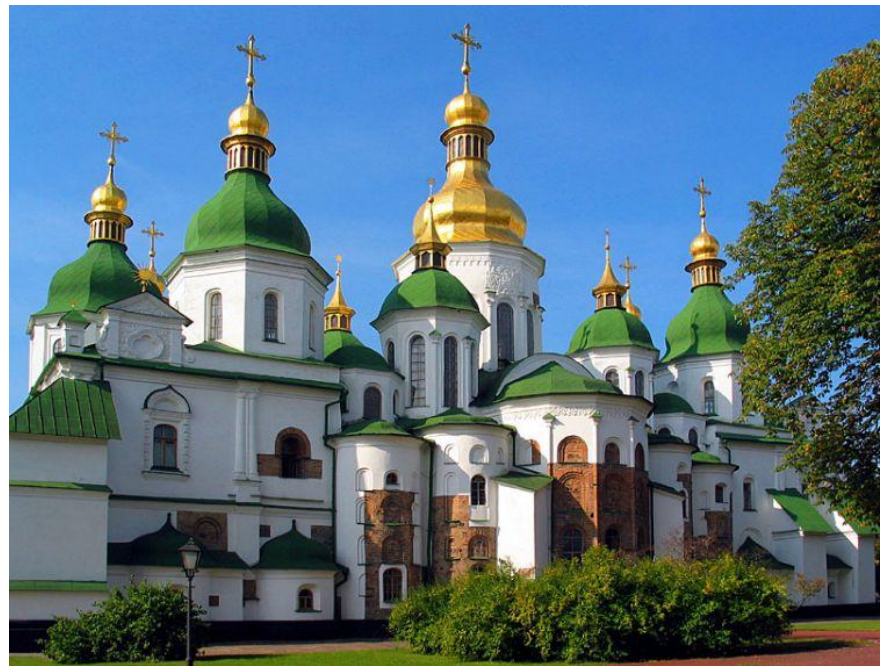

Kiev Pechersk Lavra (the Kiev Monastery of the Caves)

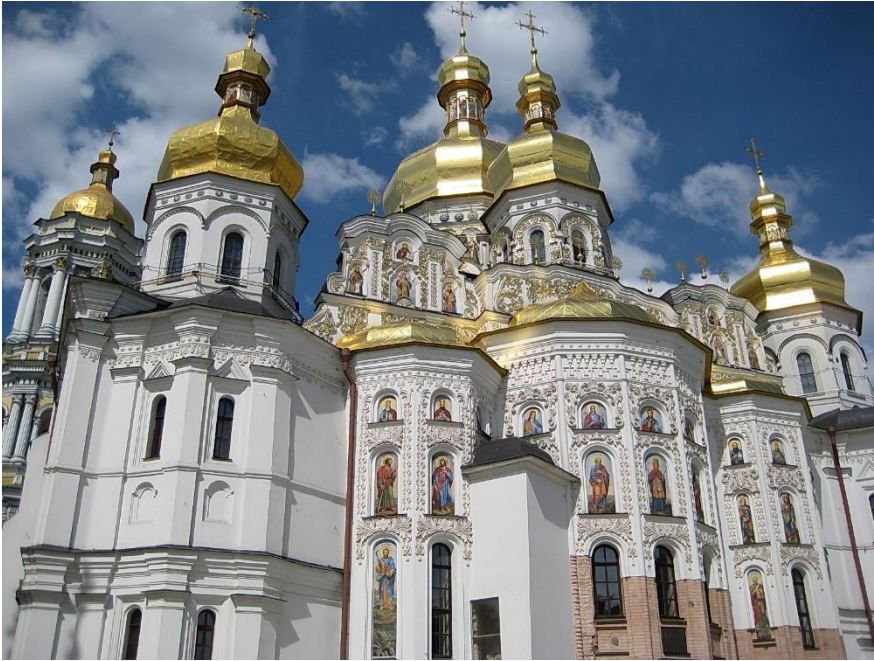
It is a historic Orthodox Christian monastery
