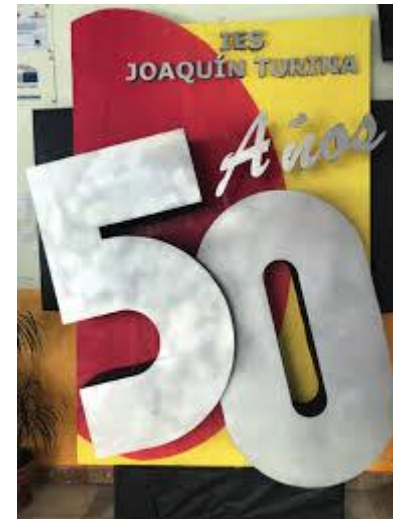




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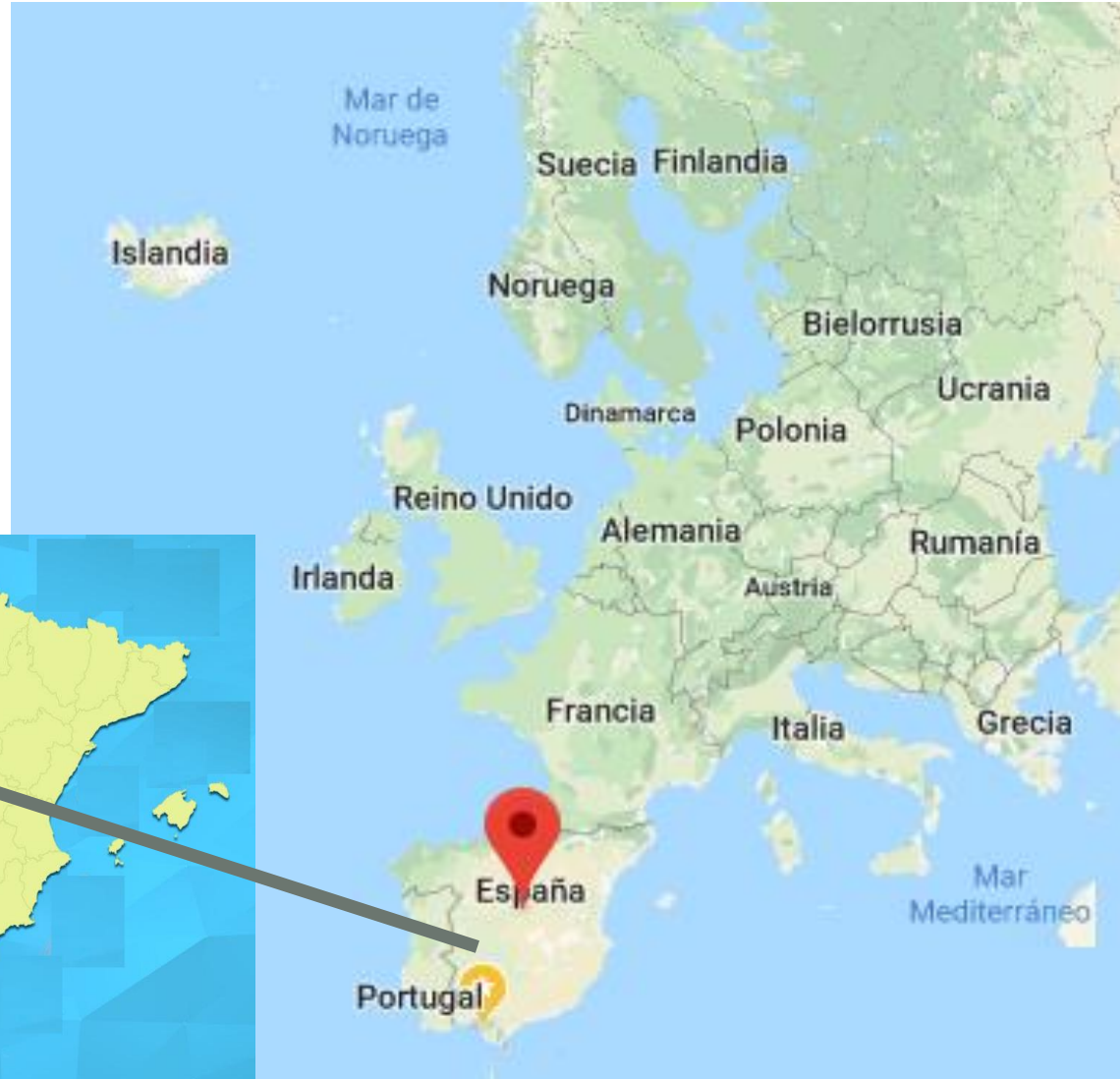

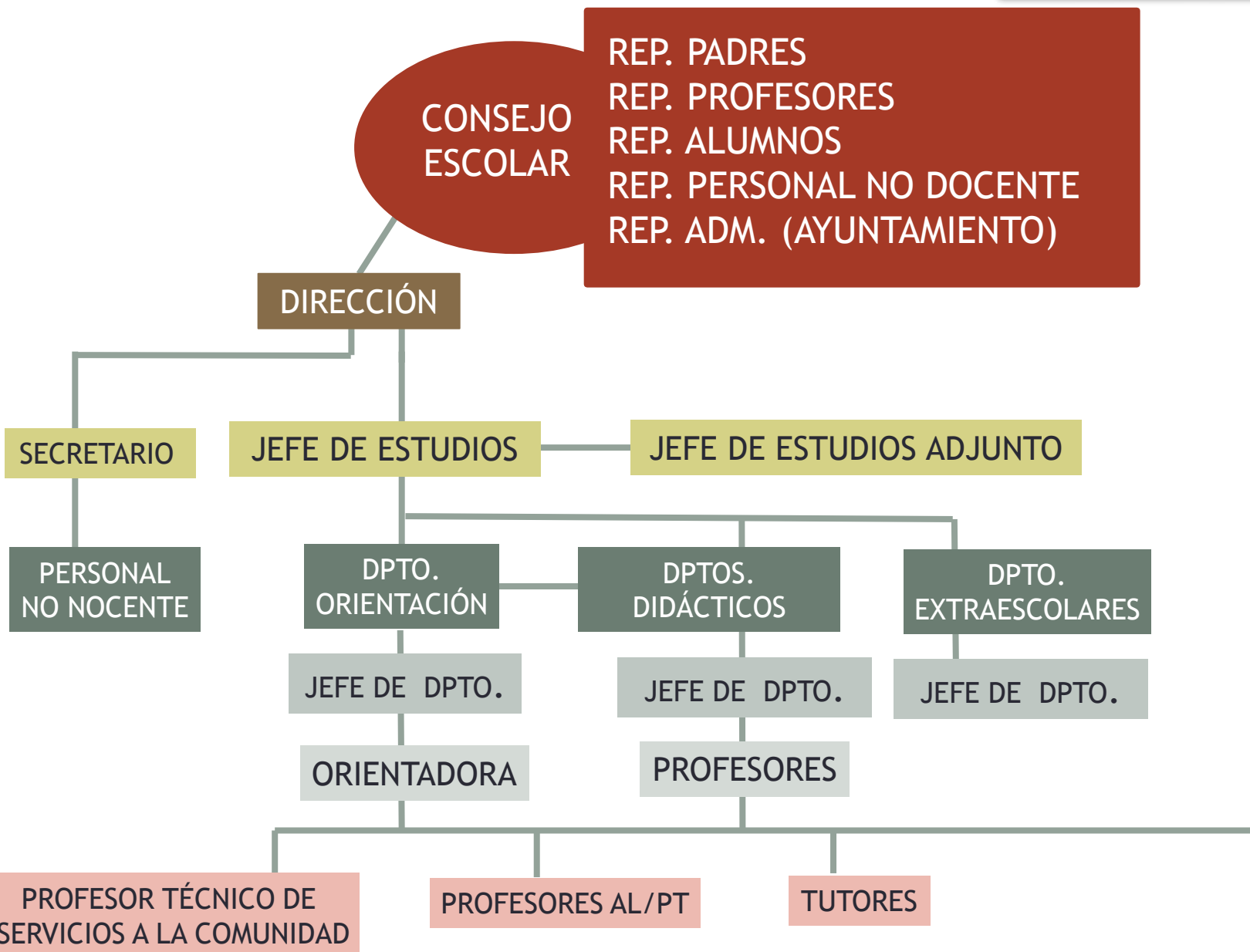
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ORGANIGRAMA

- ◉ The high-school also has a choir conducted by the philosophy teacher.





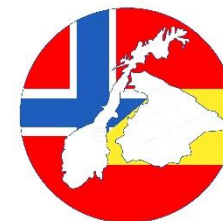

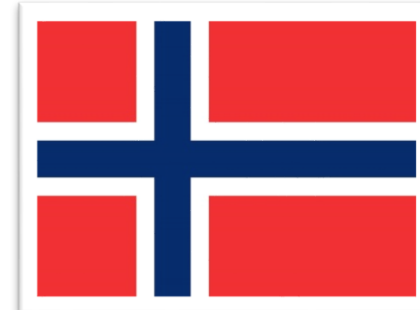


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ERASMUS+
