- 1. Given the aims and the mutual purpose of the cooperative bank, does the specific knowledge of the reference area, the proximity to the local clients for which the bank has first-rate information on the relative credit worthiness, favour the establishment of lasting economic-financial relations with customers/shareholders and above all foster business activity?
- 2. What are the changes that the current health emergency (covid-19) has imposed on the banking system during the lockdown period?
- 3. How much has the use of remote banking increased, given that consumption has become "forcibly" digital both for primary goods and for banking and financial products?
- 4. What is the role of the bank in granting benefits to companies in difficulty for credit access and liquidity support, granted by the Prime Minister's Decrees, in this covid period?
