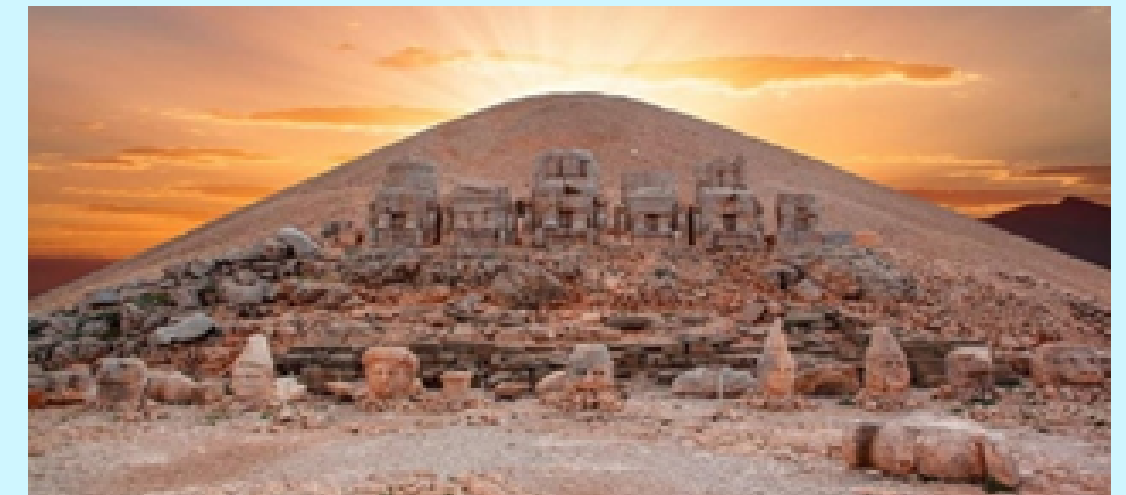

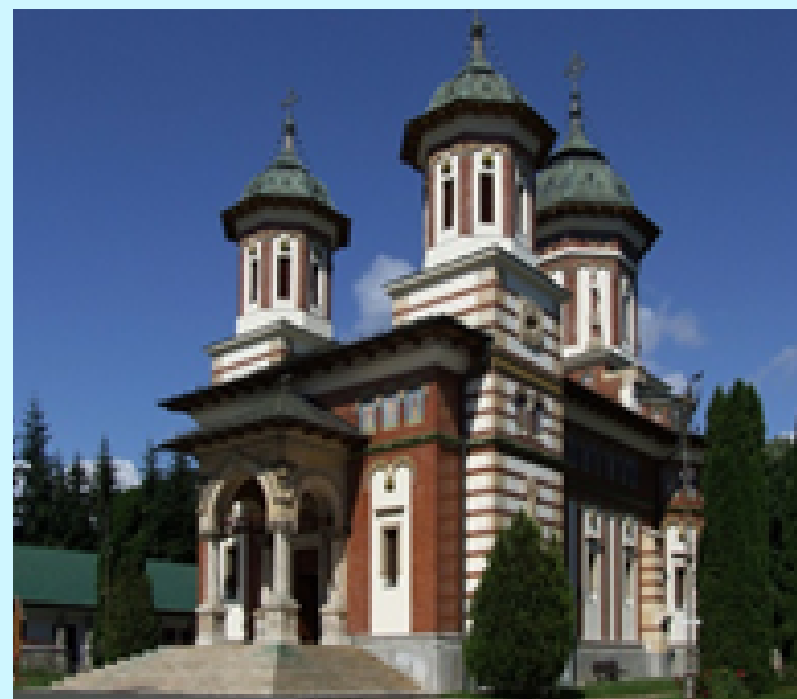

Bulgaria-Etara is an impressive open-air ethnographic museum. It is located in the quarter of the city of Gabrovo on the North flanks of Central Stara Planina. It occupies a total area of 60 decares. The exposition shows before visitors (with the participation of craftsmen and animators) the architecture, ethnography, folklore, ancient crafts, traditional cuisine, home arrangement and clothing of the Gabrovo region in the 18th and 19th centuries

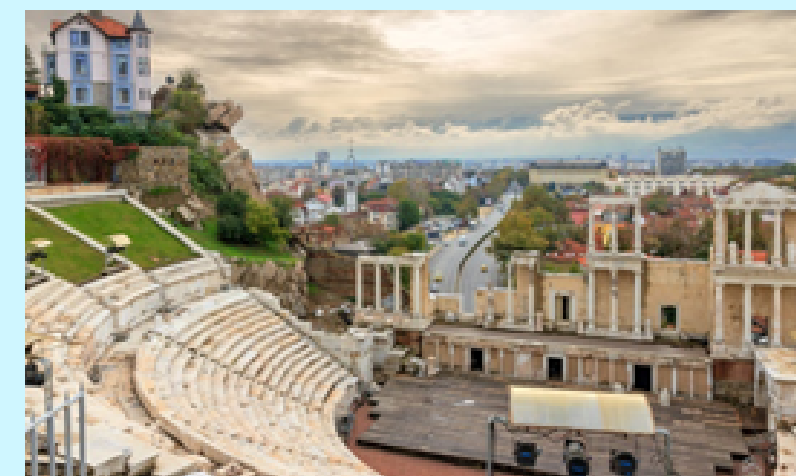

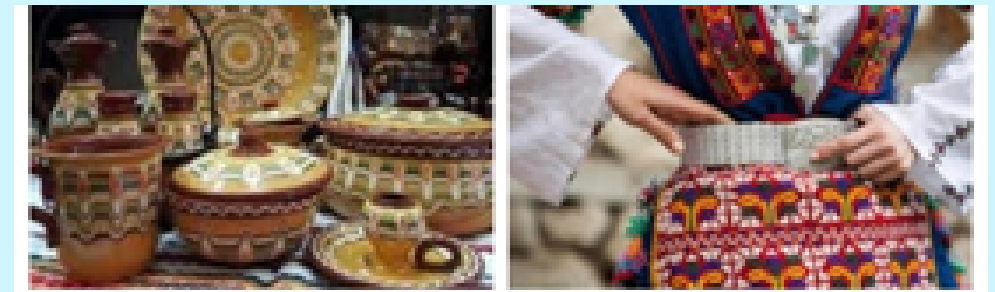

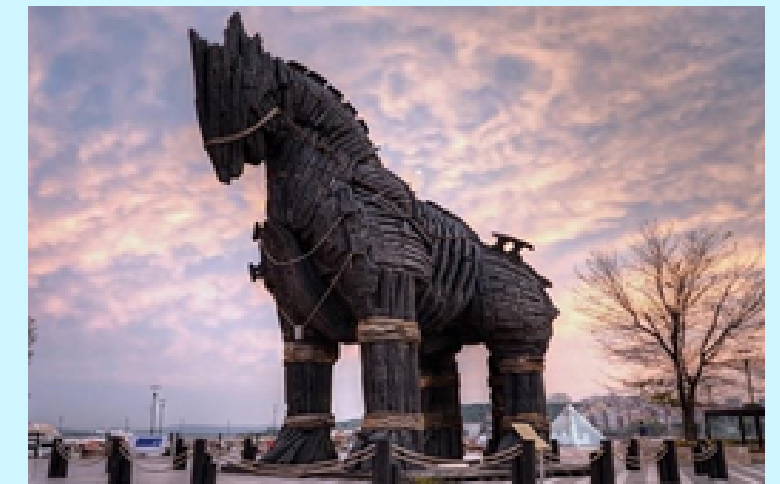

Bulgaria-Rose Holiday in the Rose valley. It is traditionally organized in the city of Kazanlak, a center of rose growing and processing. The festivities open with the rituals of rose picking and rose brewing performed by girls in multicolored folk costumes



Turkey-Galata Tower was built in 528 by the Byzantine Emperor Anastasius Oilosuz . It was originally built as a lighthouse to guide sailors .First, this structure, made only of wood, burned in battle. it was then made again with the conquest of Istanbul and was also used for observations. It is 69.90 meters high and has 9 floors.



Italy-Le Castella Castle. Among the most impressive castles of Calabria, the Aragonese castle of Le Castella it has over time become a symbol of cultural tourism in the region. Located on a small strip of land overlooking the beautiful Costa dei Saraceni in the hamlet of Le Castella town of Isola Capo Rizzuto, the beautiful fortress of Le Castella it is what remains of a large area which was to constitute a real village with walls

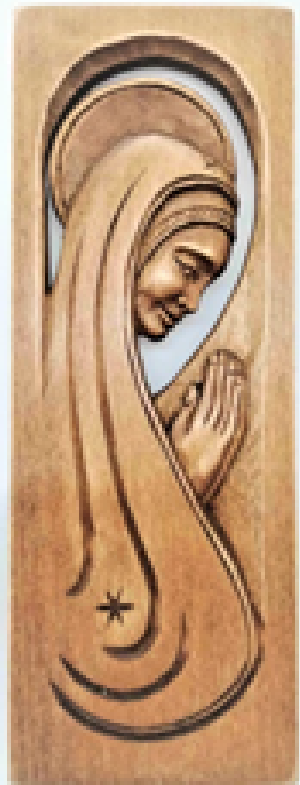

Turkey- The Marbling Art. The simplicity of water, festivity of color, emotions of human beings, perfection of nature and uniqueness of God come together in art of ebru.



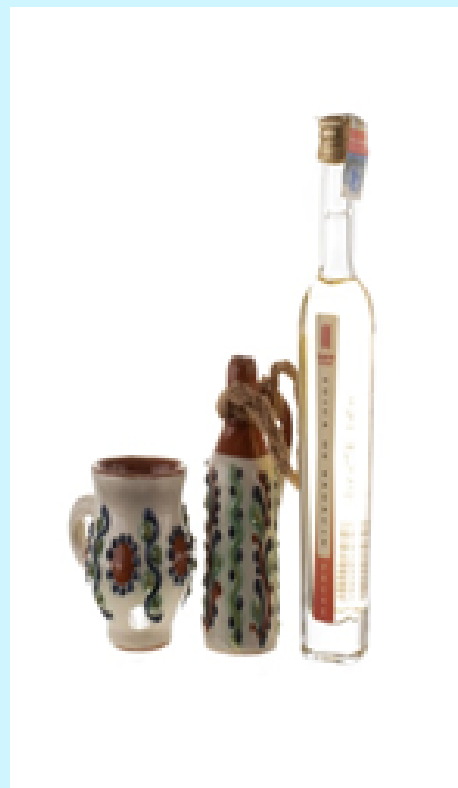
