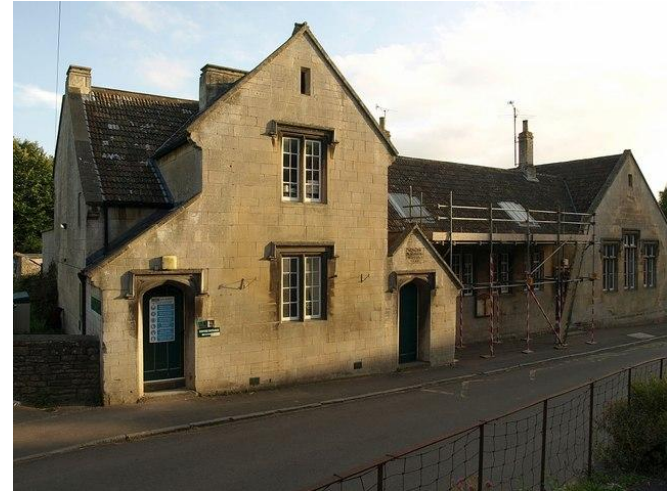
Wellow ford
