

Uluru (Ayers Rock) is a massive sandstone rock formation in Australia's Northern Territory. It is a UNESCO World Heritage site and is sacred to the First Australian (Aboriginal) indigenous people, who first settled in the area more than 30,000 years ago. Landscape paintings and drawings of rock itself have been produced by First Australian artists such as **Danny Eastwood (see image to the right)** using traditional techniques and natural pigments (colours) and these images have inspired many other artists.
