It borders on Italy, Croatia, Austria and Hungary.




This small country covers an area of only 20,273 km<sup>2</sup>.

# Sights in Slovenia; Postojna cave

- ▶ **Postojna Cave** is a karst cave system. It is the second longest cave system.

- ▶ It is famous for its green lake, a lovely church on the island, and a medieval castle on a rocky cliff.

- ▶ **Piran** is one of the loveliest coastal towns in Slovenia.
- ▶ It is known for its church and an angel.



# Ljubljana, the capital

- ▶ It's located in the centre of the country.
- ▶ It's an old city. The Romans built a military camp there and named it Emona. There are still many structures left from that period.

- ▶ Being the largest city, it's also the cultural, educational, economic, and political centre of the country. It houses Slovenia's largest shopping centres and biggest business companies.

- ▶ The banks of the Ljubljanica River are surrounded by trees and grassy areas.



- ▶ **Potica** is made from different types of dough and different fillings. The most typical filling includes walnuts. It is one of the original Slovene desserts.




# Slovene athletes
