
## News Report Scaffold – 5Ws



**Remember** the **News report** is like a dog on a lead. It is made up of these four main parts:

The <u>Headline</u> which is the hook that catches the reader. The <u>Lead</u> which leads the reader to the most important detail so they want to read the <u>Body</u> of the story. And finally, the <u>Tail</u> which has more information but not as important to the story as it may be cut. (like some dogs' tails).

When we write a newspaper report it is a good idea to establish the main points first. We can think of this as the 5Ws (+ H - if you know it).
