water or butter milk.

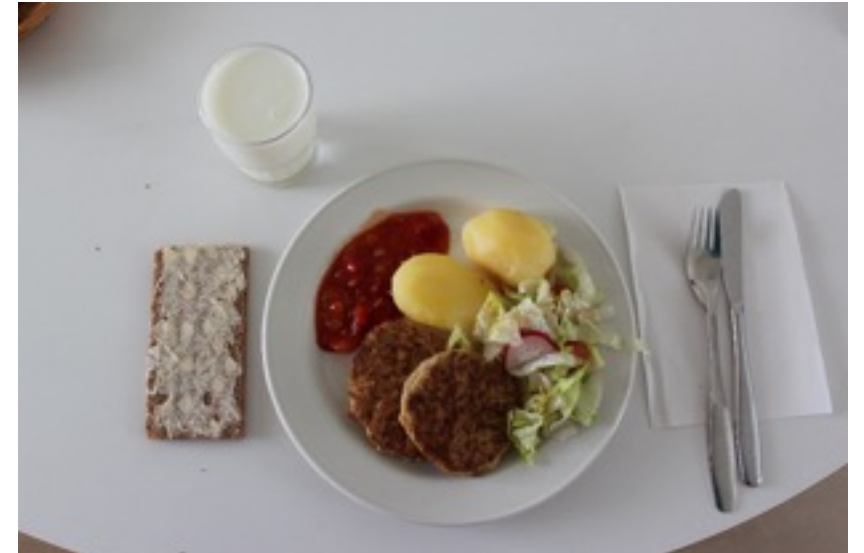
I like boiled potatoes.

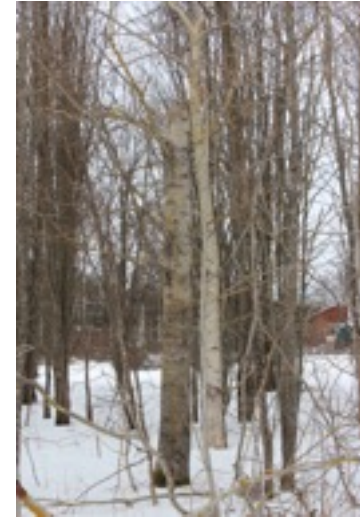




spruce and birch

willow

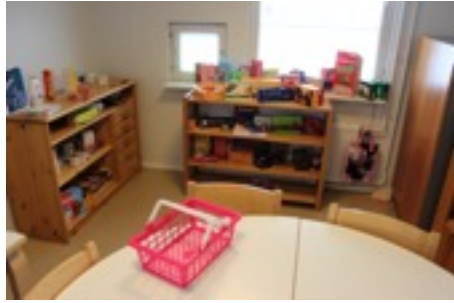


goat willow

chicks



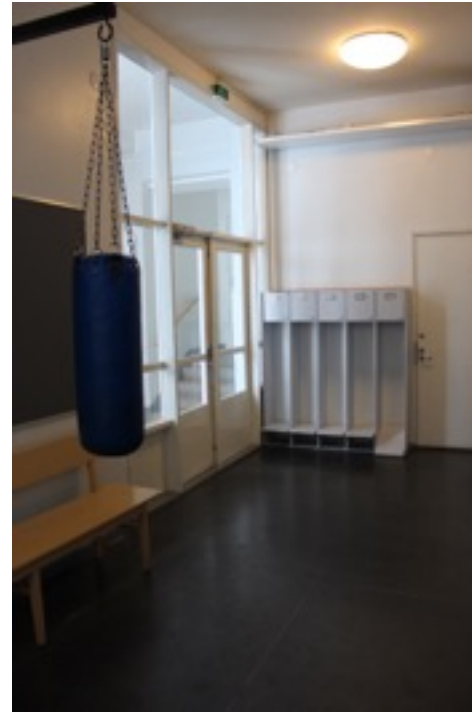
This is the cake mountain.
