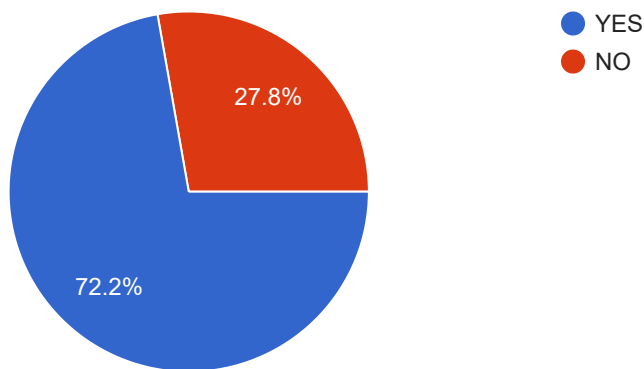

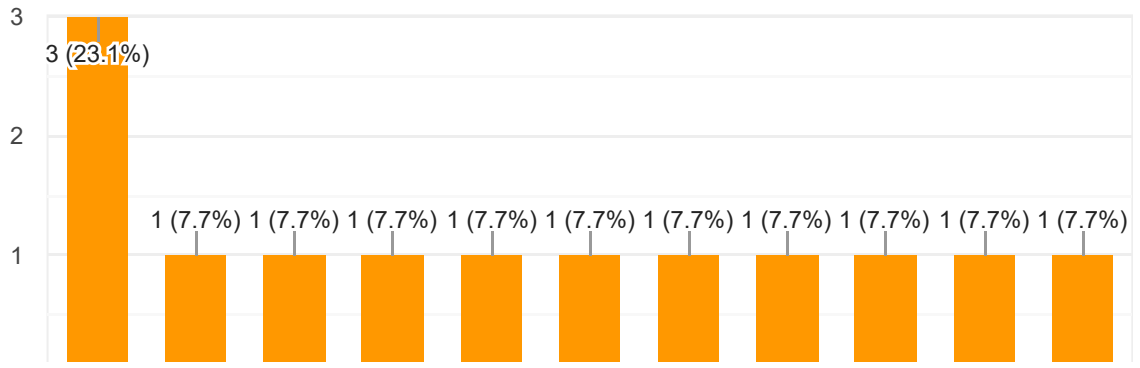

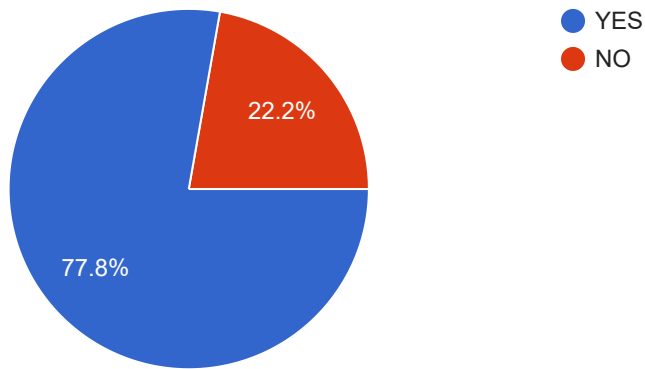

In Cudillero(Spain) there is a church of les Selgas

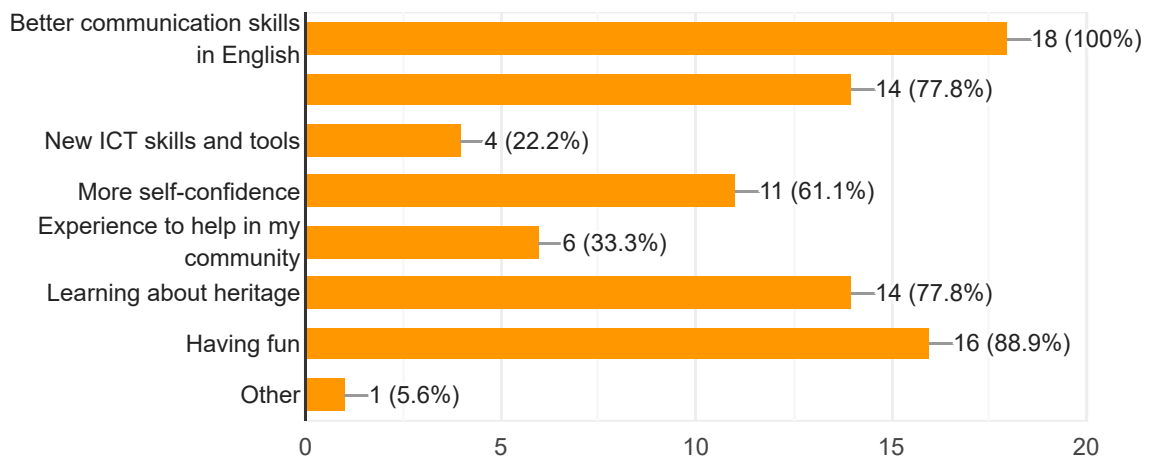
In Cudillero, there is the Selgas Palace, the "Jesús de Nazareno's Chruch"
