Visit in Poland

The imaginary trip around castles and forest

From May 9 to May 14, teachers and students from Italy and Spain visited the school in Iłowo-Osada in Poland. During the visit, students stayed at homes of their colleagues from Poland. Even before arrival, students contacted each other via messengers.

Each day was filled with classes at school and activities in other interesting places.

On the first day, students took part in a performance prepared by Polish students as "Steve in the computer world". One of the teachers from Spain wrote in her report from Poland "The presentation was great; It was obvious that they were preparing for it, so we felt very grateful that they honored us with the action they devoted so much effort. The truth is that it was an example work, positive values and enthusiasm. " After the performance, there were drama and dance workshops led by students Amelia Lipowska and Karolina Grzymkowska at the Centre of Culture and Sport in Iłowo-Osada. The afternoon was an opportunity to integrate and have fun at the bowling club in Działdowo.

On the second day, students of V-VIII classes prepared classes in the form of stations using methods developing creativity and modern technologies (including tablets purchased as part of the project). Participants solved tasks concerning the geography and nature of individual countries, built castles of different materials, participated in chemical experiments and baked cookies. In the afternoon we visited the Teutonic Castle in Działdowo and took part in the show and competition led by the Brotherhood of Knights from Działdowo.

On Saturday, students visited the medieval Castle of the Mazovian Dukes in Ciechanów and the Museum of Romanticism in Opinogóra, where they took part in creative activities, prepared a card with memories. We spent Sunday in Warsaw - in the Old Town and in the Royal Castle in Łazienki. At the end of the day we had fun at the Gravity Station.

On Monday morning, students in an international group took part in sports competitions. Sports competitions were prepared and led by a group of students who prepared and conducted the entire event under the guidance of teachers.

In the afternoon, after visiting the castle in Nidzica, students participated in pottery workshops in the "Pottery Village" in Kamionka. In the evening we met at a party that was an opportunity to thank everyone.

Tuesday surprised us with rainy weather, so instead of planned walks in the woods, students from our school conducted a nature game at school. After it, we went on foot to Dwukoły forest, where employees of the Dwukoły Forest District prepared a bonfire for us. Mr. Jacek Folborski showed us around the newly created centre of nature and forest.

Meeting with colleagues from other countries was a unique opportunity for us for personal development, broaden our horizons, and practice language and communication skills. We are extremely grateful to those who supported us in the preparation and organization of this visit.

REPORT AFTER MOBILITY

The mobility in Poland involved a total of 28 students from Italy and Spain and 48 students from Poland.

Participants explored together the cultural Heritage of Iłowo-Osada and Warsaw. They worked collaboratively and rethink creatively the cultural aspects they have explored through a drama.

They have used competences acquired in mother tongue, English, history, geography, science, art to describe the context, historical sites, the forest to perform a drama.

During the mobility were organized activities in the school:

drama and dance workshop

Workshop about different contents of project:

- a. culture and traditional food,
- b. history and art pupils observe different castles in Poland and recreated one of them with different materials. At the end of the workshop 4 different castles were realized with different techniques,
- c. Nature studies: students were involved in games with digital tools (kahoot) to explore flora of countries involved in the project,
- d. Science: students were involved in experiments and games to explore the chemical elements.

Sport event: teams' competition.

Other activities were organized outside the school:


- a. in the Castles in order to know more about the ancient history of Poland: tour with guide; exhibition of knights and performance of students,
- b. In a pottery village to immerse in the traditional culture of Poland; students were involved in a creative workshop,
- c. Tour guide in Warsaw in order to know the most recent history of Warsaw and Poland.
- d. Activities in the forest.

Students were also involved in a range number of social activities in order to reinforce their ties: sport activities in the gym and in the park, trampoline park, excursion in the forest with the host families.

The short exchanges of group of pupils involved the whole Community around Iłowo-Osada in the project activities. It strengthen ties with partner. It will reinforced the idea of European citizenship. Pupils from all three countries had the opportunity to improve their language skills in English. The ability to use different languages to communicate with pairs. They put into practice the competencies acquired at their own school. They improved the ability to work collaboratively at international level. The teachers from all schools improve their knowledge about the Erasmus+Programme. They improved foreign language skills. They improve and exchange knowledge on different school organizations. They exchange the different knowledge and way to teach the subjects and the use of digital resources in teaching/ learning.
