## School System Background

- 1939-1975 monolingual school. Foreign languages: Latin, Greek and French
- 1975 \& 1979 Democracy and Autonomy. The

Government's Education Department responsible for the Educational system administration

- Since 1983 Implementation action plan for bilingual education.
- 2006 New Catalan Statute of Autonomy. Specifies the competences in education


## Competences Catalan Education System

- Establishment of the educative contents of the first cycle of infant education (0-3 years)
- Creation and organisation of state schools.
- Inspection, education system internal evaluation, innovation, investigation and educational experimentation.
- Continuous teacher training and educative services


## Competences Catalan Education System

Shared competences:

- Spanish state $55 \%$ of the general curriculum and $45 \%$ of the curriculum set by the Catalan government
- General evaluation of the Education system.


## General Information

- It is regulated by the Ley Orgánica $8 / 2013$, de 9 de diciembre, para la mejora de la calidad educativa (LOMCE, Organic Law for the improvement of educational quality)
- Compulsory between 6 and 16 years


## Rights and duties of the students

Every child has the right to education, no matter their place of origin or their place of residence. This right is independent from their and their families' administrative situation, even if they have no residence permit.

- To receive an education enabling the development of their personality.
- That their particular education needs are taken into account.
- That their freedom of consciousness, their moral and religious beliefs, their language, their culture and their personal dignity are respected.
- To receive academic and professional guidance.


## Rights and duties of the students

- To participate in learning activities.
- To respect all the members of the education community, and to follow the teachers' guidance.
- To attend classes regularly and on time during the compulsory education period, which concerns children up to 16.
- To respect the school facilities and material.
- To respect the rules of organisation, interaction and order of schools


## Types of schools

- Public or State Schools
- Grant aided Private Schools (Private but subsidised with public funds)
- Independent Private Schools


## School Year

The school year runs from September to June. It is divided by three calendar quarters.

- The first quarter runs from September to Christmas holidays, which last 15 days.
- The second quarter runs from January to Easter holidays, which last 10 days.
- The third quarter runs from Easter holidays to the end of June.
- Summer holidays include the months of July, August and the first week of September.
