- paid or voluntary workers
- Most of the time it is free, but in some parts of the world you have to pay for the rescue service (f.e. Switzerland)

- Available 365/7/24
- Existence of special groups for things like canyoning, avalanches (SAR dogs), cable car evacuations..
- Alpine Emergency number: 140
- Funding of the organization: donations, supporter programme, billing of call outs and government contribution

Basics:

-> Missing individual, time pressure, friends and relatives, etc..



- 1. Situation Assessment
- 2. Planning
- 3. Decision and realisation
- 4. Continued reassessment and adaptment of actions if necessary



Technical gadgets and tools

- Mobile phones -> GPS and various Apps
- GPS transmitters
- Satellite transmitters
- IMSI Catchers
- FLIR Helicopters
- Night Vision Goggles
- Database (Police, Hospitals, Ambulance Service,..)
