

The dominant religious is the *Romanian Orthodox Church,* its members represent 87% of the population.

Other important Christian churches from Romania are: Roman Catholics (4.7%), Protestants (3.7%), Pentecostals (1.5%) and the Romanian Greek-Catholic Church (0.9%). Romania has many touristic places, which attract millions of tourists: natural parks, monasteries, traditional villages, old and modern cities.


