The dominant religious is the **Romanian Orthodox Church**, its members represent 87% of the population.

Other important Christian churches from Romania are: Roman Catholics (4.7%), Protestants (3.7%), Pentecostals (1.5%) and the Romanian Greek-Catholic Church (0.9%).

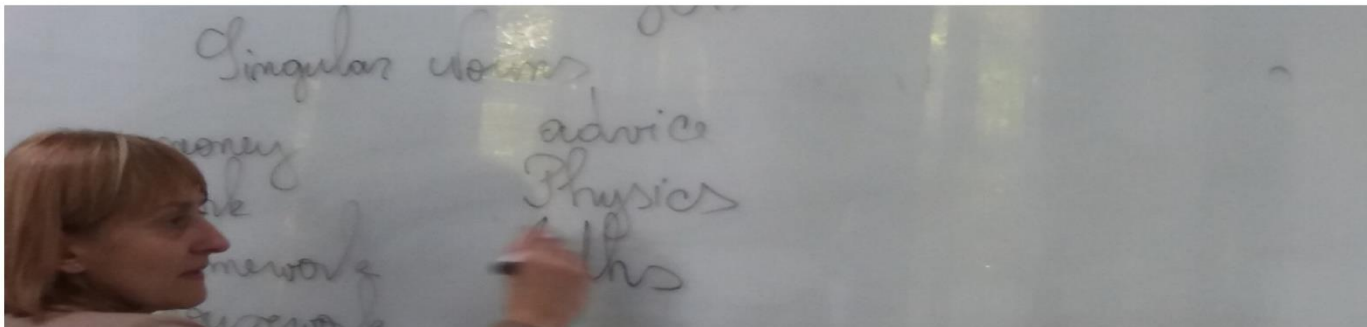

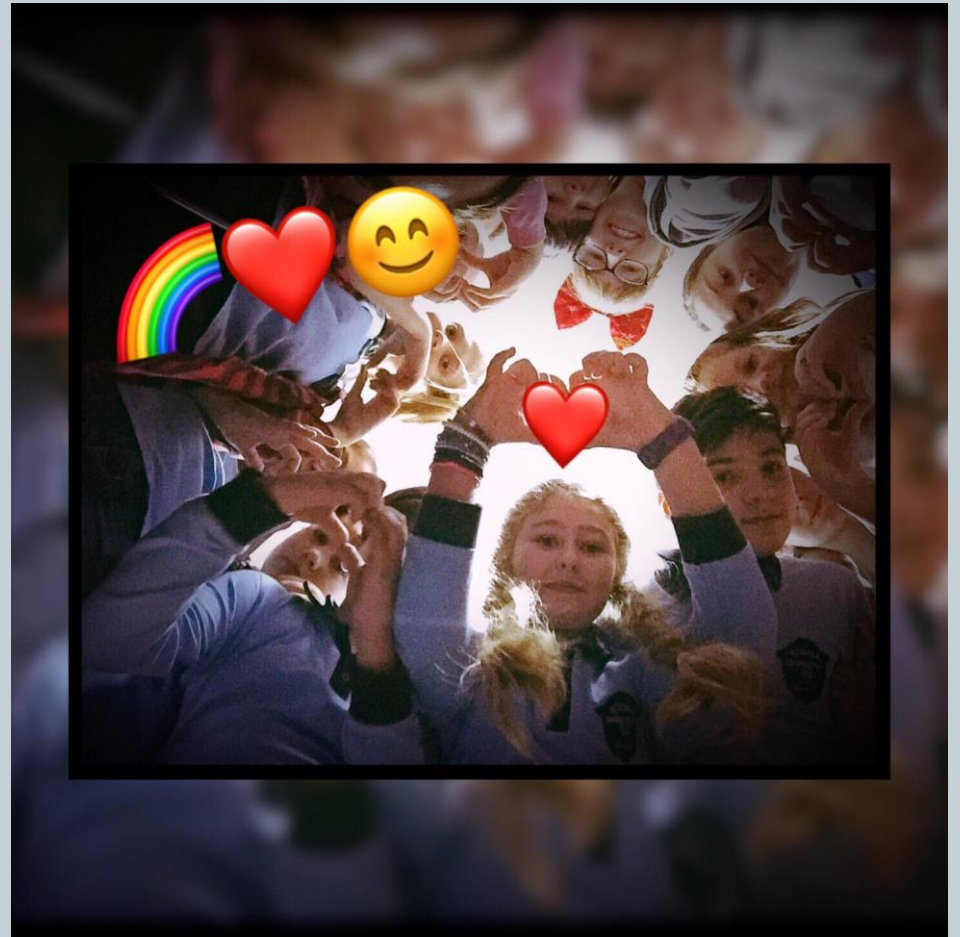

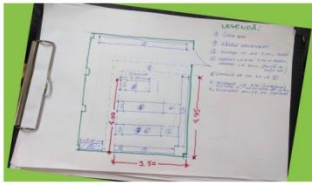
OUR PROJECTS
