
Reich Annexes Danzig; Attacks Polish Border Blames Warsaw Army

On September 1st, 1939 the world watched in shocked silence as the armies of Nazi Germany stormed into Poland unleashing a new and horrifying type of warfare, they called it "BLITZKRIEG" – "THE LIGHTNING WAR"...



3th of September 1939 Great Britain and France declares war to Germany, but not a single bullet has been fired. It was named the Phony War because they didn't intended at all to provoke Hitler.

Polish Army Officer whose unit was stationed on the Polish-Soviet border in September 1939.


In fact the Polish, the Romanians and the entire World didn't knew that Hitler and Stalin have agreed to divide the Eastern Europe between them!

Polonia has been divided by the two Totalitarian powers (Germany and USSR) and it disapeared.




The Polish tragedy has not remained unnotiched in Romania.

Polish officials have been refugees in Romania

During the night of 17 September 1939, after Poland had been entirely conquest, the Polish Government, the president Ignacy Moscicki, the Foreign Minster Beck and other officials have crossed the Romanian border








Polish officials have been refugees in Romania

The President have been hosted in Bicaz, which was the nearest domain of the Romanian Crown, then, on 25 December 1939 he have left to Switzerland.

The Foreign Minister, Jozef Beck, has been accommodated by the authorities at a luxurious hotel in Brasov. There he wrote a volume of memoirs, *Ostatni raport* (*Final Report*).






He died in Romania, on 5 June 1944. In May 1991, Beck's remains were repatriated to Poland and interred at Warsaw's Powazki Military Cemetery.

România in a great danger

Romania was practically the only European state which took this risk. Two days after the Polish President arrived at Bicaz, the Prime minister, Armand Călinescu, has been assasinated by a comando trained and sent from Germany.





"The Golden Train"

The entire Gold thesaurus of the National Bank of Poland has been sent to Romania in order to tranzit to the West! A part of it remained in Bucharest. On 10 October1939, the Bank Polski delegation has been given to the National Bank of Romania 51 wooden boxes, containing 2.734 kg pure Gold.



In September 1947 the Gold were returned to Warsaw

"The Neptun Operation"

In June 1944, the authorities took the decision to transport the entire gold (including the Polish one) to Tismana Monastery.



Only in February 1947 it was possible to return the Gold to Bucharest!

Wawel Castle Thesaurus

On 17 September1939, the Wawel Caslte Thesaurus has been also transferred to Romania.

It contained priceless items, like:

- the Incoronation of the Polish kings sword;
- the Knight of the Order of the Holy Spirit cape, gift from Louis XIV after the siege of Vienna;
- a Crown since 1792;
- the tapistery collection of Sigismund al II-lea August.







Wawel Castle Thesaurus

The thesaurus remained in Bucharest until November 1939, then sent to France from Constanta. Here it has been completed with the most precious manuscripts of the Polish National Library. :

- The Gutenberg Bible (1453-1455), one of the 45 known existing pieces;
- 49 of the Chopin.'s manuscripts





More than 100.000 Polish refugees came to Romania, being accommodated here and helped to continue their journey to the Western countries.











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
