VISIT TO BUCHAREST—ROMANIA

13th —18th of October 2019

The meeting in Romania was held at the Scoala Junior High School no. 92 and Liceul technologic "Sfantul Pantelimon in Bucharest . Two students from each partner school took part in the meeting, accompanied by the two teachers of the TPM. The theme was the Victory of Democracy in Europe.

The goals of the meeting included the development of cooperation, group work skills, use of ICT, presentation of historical events that had an impact on the history of the continent in the twentieth century, development of critical thinking, analysis of historical events, discussion skills, as well as inclusion of elements of informal education, increasing historical awareness, democratic and European.



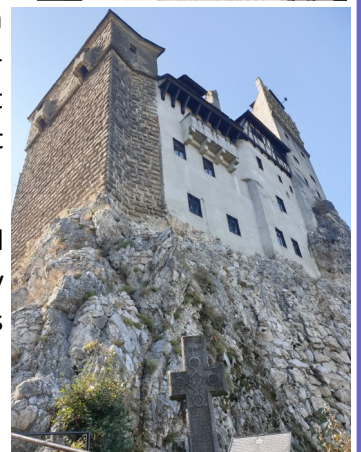
The first day was devoted to integration classes in Extreme Park Cernica . On Monday, the Technological High School "Sfantul Pantelimon was visited, and then the students participated in the workshop "What I like about Romania ", followed by a demonstration of historical presentations on the history of the second half of the 20th century "Triumph of democracy" .



On Tuesday, the students took part in a round trip around Bucharest entitled "From communism to democracy", during which they got to know the most important places of events in 1989 (Revolution Square, Dom Ceausescu). In the afternoon, project participants visited the Parliament of Bucharest .



On Wednesday, students learned about the history of Romania by visiting the Carpathians, and places such as Sinaia, Bran and Brasov.



On Thursday there were tourist fairs at Scoala Gimnaziala nr. 92. Students from each country brought materials prepared earlier to promote their country to prepare a stall devoted to culture, geography and history of their country. Each team presented the tourist attractions of the country of origin to other partners. Then, students worked on travel diaries and final presentations during the "Europe in the box" workshops. On Friday morning, students prepared their final presentations with presentations showing what they learned during this meeting.

During the final meeting coordinators of all the partner countries participated in order to close the programmes and summarize the final products. The meeting was mainly devoted to the final report. All meeting participants logged in to their Mobility Tool to discuss how to fill each tab. The coordinator presented the content of the final report and partners discussed each of the report's questions, analyzed the degree of achievement of the objectives, the implementation of individual products, the profile of students involved, the quality of implementation of individual activities and organization of meetings.

Particular emphasis was placed on the dissemination of the project in individual countries (publications in the press, lessons, use of project materials, meetings, exhibitions, photo presentations, etc.), exchanged comments and observations.

During the meeting the teachers also visited the chocolate Museum, Montse Monastery and the old city of Barcelona.
