- We work according to all legal regulations..

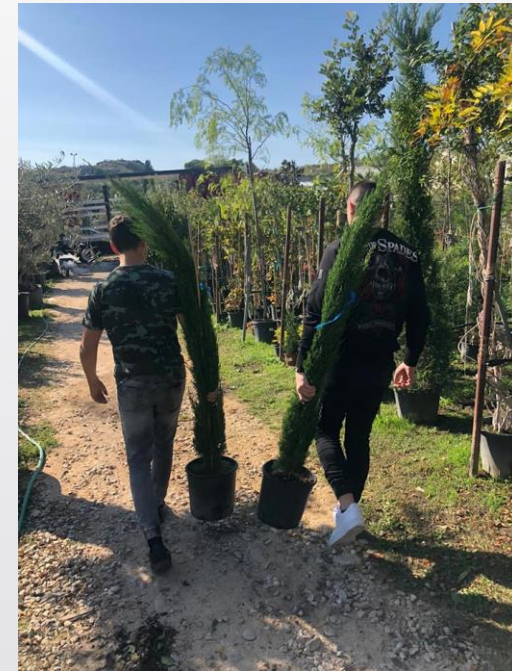


School volunteer club

- In 2019/2020., the volunteer project "art-help" received the national award "National Foundation for Civil Society Development" for an innovative volunteering model, development of philanthropy and social engagement in the Republic of Croatia
- Volunteer project "art-help" - young artists of our School (students-volunteers) teach, help and relax users through art-educational-relaxing workshops.
- We offered our workshops to various institutions: primary schools, libraries, old people's homes, institutions for children with disabilities, children's homes, hospitals...
- The leader and author of the "art-help" project is the school pedagogue Aleksandra Dužević, and all workshops are prepared and designed according to the principle of pedagogical workshops, adapted to the age and interest of users: topic, goal, outcomes, timeline, evaluation.



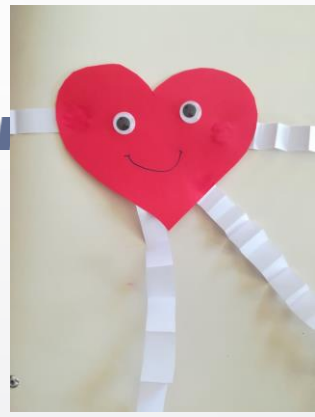
