



















11. On a scale from 1 to 5 please rate the quality of the following activities:









For me everything was different,never having traveled abroad,but everything was beautiful



The school is very big and very clean and they are all good at speaking English, so we understood what they were saying





The thing I liked most was the guited tours from which we learned a lot of new things.


The thing I liked the least was the last day we had to say goodbye.
