

# Itinerary for CLIL Meeting

18th-25th January, 2016

SPAIN

## Monday 18th

- **11:30** – Dutch guests arrive at school.
- **14:00** – Italian guests arrive at school.
- **14:30** – Guest students from both countries will go home with their respective hosts and guest teachers will be driven to their hotel.
- **24:20** – Polish guests arrive at Hotel Europa, where students will be picked up by their host families and driven home.

## Tuesday 19th

- **08:30-14:30** – Guest students attend both CLIL and non-CLIL lessons with their hosts and go back home after school.
- **18:20** – Slovenian guests arrive at Hotel Europa, where the students will be picked up by their host families and driven home.

## Wednesday 20th

- **08:30-14:30** – Guest students attend both CLIL and non-CLIL lessons with their hosts and go back home after school.
- **14:00** – Spanish tapas (€15 per person) for both guest and host teachers at a nearby restaurant (La Tapería).
- **15:30** – Back to school: Welcome by the Regional Education Representative and CLIL methodology workshop run by Paul Daly (Cambridge teacher trainer).

## Thursday 21st

- **8:30-14:30** – Guest students attend both CLIL and non-CLIL lessons with their hosts and go back home after school.
- **14:30** – Walk to a nearby restaurant (La Falla), where all teachers and students will have a paella menu (€ 12 per student and €18 per teacher).
- **16:30** – Walk around Albacete.
- **19:30** (approximately) – End of the visit and free time.

## Friday 22nd

- **08:30** – Guests attend school with their hosts during the 1<sup>st</sup> period.
- **09:30** – Institutional visit: The Head of the Regional Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport in Castille-La Mancha will visit the school and have an interview with all guest and host teachers and students.

- **10:20**– Trip to Alcalá del Júcar and Chinchilla (€10 per person + about €4 per person for the guided tour of Chinchilla). The meal will be a packed lunch that guest students will be provided with by their host families, and teachers can get one at the school canteen for about €5.
- **18:30** – Trip back to Albacete. The students will be dropped at the school gate at about 19:00 and the teachers will be driven to their hotel.
- **21:00** – Farewell meal for guest teachers (about €18 per person, drinks not included).

### **Saturday 23rd**

- **08:30** – Italian guest students and teachers will be driven to the train station before their departure at 09:00.
- **16:30** – Dutch teachers will be driven to school, where they will meet their students for their departure by bus.

### **Sunday 24th**

- **08:30** – Slovenian teachers will be driven to school, where they will meet their students for their departure by bus.

### **Monday 25th**

- **Place and time still to be determined** (probably at the bus station early in the morning before school starts) – Polish guest students and teachers will be driven to the station for their departure.

### **Notes:**

- All guests will be provided with a detailed timetable of activities during school time.
- Guest teachers will accompany their students and watch/collaborate during lessons and activities.
- The expenses underlined in this programme are the following:
  - Spanish tapas: €15.
  - Paella: €12 per student and €18 per teacher.
  - Friday trip: €10 per person.
  - Guided tour of Chinchilla: €4 approximately.
  - Packed lunch: €5 approximately per teacher.
  - Farewell meal: €18 per person (drinks not included).
- When there are no activities planned, the host families may organise what they consider most convenient for their guests.
