<p>STUDENTS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Many activities which were engaging, interesting, fun, dynamic and well-structured. • Very satisfying, because we could cooperate and participate and learn new things. <p>TEACHERS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Very interesting and a clear presentation of contents. • Students are forced to speak and think in English (although they sometimes use their mother tongue), and this effort allows them to get out a lot more of the lesson than in non-CLIL lessons. 	<p>STUDENTS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not many activities. • Too easy. • Students didn't speak much English. <p>TEACHERS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Too much mother tongue (1 person).

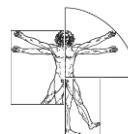
