# 1. Geographic area

The cane rociera is a traditional instrument **of Andalusia**, its name comes from the fact that its use is very common in the pilgrimage of El Rocío.



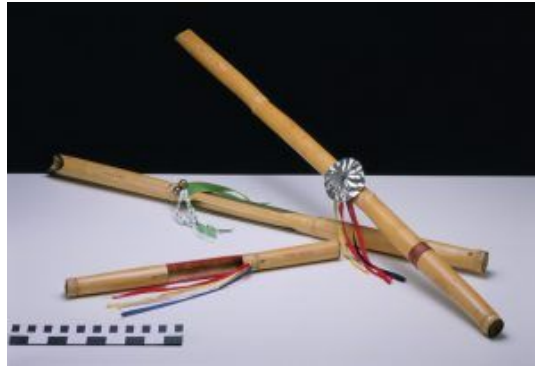
## 2.Craft Characteristics

It is usually used as a secondary accompaniment instrument, also in flamenco, for groups; Sometimes you can wear jingle bells.



### 3. The technique

It consists of a piece of cane open longitudinally, thus leaving two free arms. Some reeds have a slit (or two, depending on the case), riding a fine spike (or two, depending on each model).

The exact year in which this instrument began to be played and used is unknown, but it is known that it began to be played at the Rocío party, accompanying this virgin. It is usually used only on this holiday, with religious origin.
