A famous tradition in our school occurs every year, in November. It is a nonformal activity called “The Sweets Fair”. This fair is proposed, planned and carried out by the pupils who are part of the school’s Council of Students. Together with parents and teachers, our students bake cakes which they then sell within the school’s premises. The money they collect from selling the sweets is later on used to bring joy to the less fortunate ones like the orphan children from Baicoi and Valea Plopului, in Prahova County, or the disabled patients who are institutionalised in Tuicani Hospital – Moreni. Our students donate packages with various goods which they buy with the money earned by selling the home-made sweets. Although the fair takes place in November, the heart-warming donations occur in December.
