I want to tell you about my first experience in an Erasmus project.

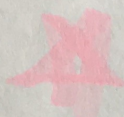
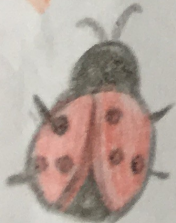
I was skeptical about this project at the beginning of seventh grade, but it turned out to be the best choice I've made.

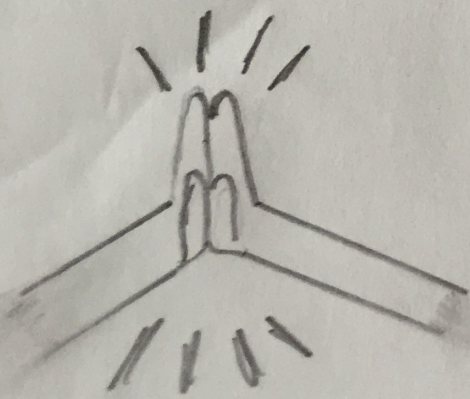
It was a very enjoyable and fun experience from which I learned many things and which I would repeat anything!
