What's the best time of the year?

The best time of the year to go to Scotland usually is around May, June or September, but that doesn't mean that it won't rain. Scotland has a tendency to being cool, rather than warm enough.



What's the worst time of the year?

The worst time of the year in Scotland are normally October, July and August. These months are usually wet and humid, and it's not the best time to go there. Most tourists also don't go because there are some bugs called midges that bite and can cause irritation.
