COMPARISON





We can compare the lyrics of the song to a famous painting by Frida Kahlo, entitled "The two Fridas"

The painting represents two self-portraits of Frida: the one loved by her husband and the one who instead faced their separation. One of her has an intact heart and holds a small pendant with the portrait of Diego in her hand, while the other holds a pair of bloody scissors with which she has torn her heart to shreds. So the boy in the song remembers the girl she loved so much, a part of him remembers the moments spent together, indelible and engraved in her heart, this is represented by Frida holding the pendant. The other part of him instead understands that it is better to let her go, that she hurt him so much and that what happened to them will remain only a beautiful memory, represented by Frida holding a pair of bloody scissors.



In this drawing two hands are represented in the act of breaking up. The guy tries to keep the girl's hand, their relationship. However, the girl has started a new life and the boy has vague memories of it, but they do not allow her to turn the page and therefore to let him go permanently.
