During the last three months and thanks to our Erasmus Plus project "Our school, our playground", we are recovering the popular games in the playground like: hopscotch, blind man's buff, noughts and crosses, pulling the rope, cops and robbers.....



Taking advantage of the father's day festivity, the students performed the game of 'noughts and crosses' to encourage family relationships through the game, and in the classroom there is "MATH corner" with manipulative games where students reinforce his learning: chopsticks, meters, tangram, clocks, in the "CORNER OF LANGUAGE" there are games of alphabet, memory ...

Taking advantage of specific dates, Halloween, end of the year ... circuits of popular games have been made at the Center level and to promote SOCIAL SKILLS within the class group, with the teacher of PT we have also practice popular and traditional games.

We have published an article in the digital magazine of Etwiining entitled our school our playground and the intangible heritage, where we have made a summary of all the activities that we are doing in our school with respect to our Erasmus plus project.

We are also painting the school playground with games, to encourage, both in the classes of C.A class, Physical education, and others, health, sports,
