


Aeneas's travel



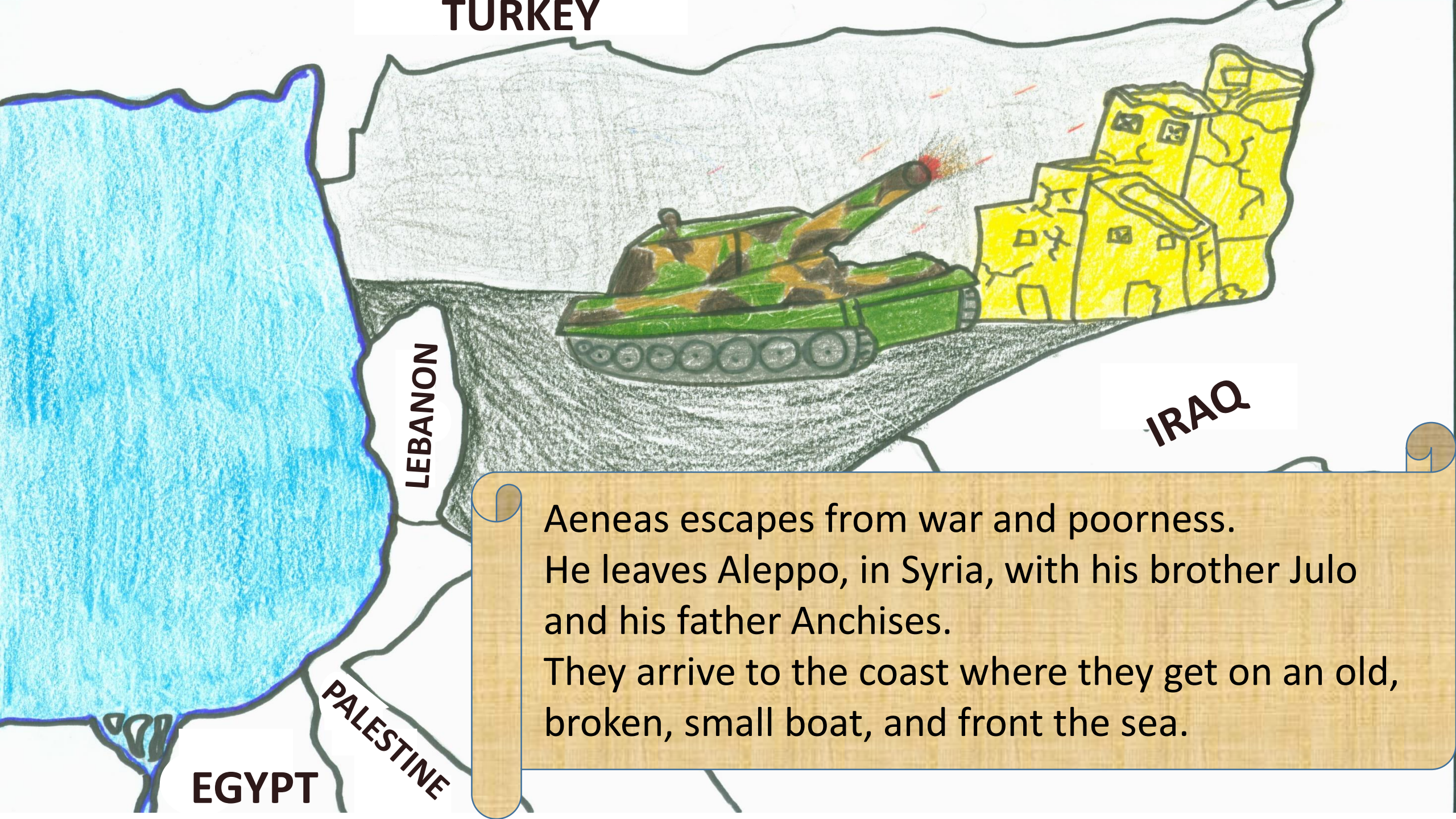


The Aeneid is a poem written by the Latin poet Virgilius, who lived during the Emperor Augustus age, in the first century before Christ.

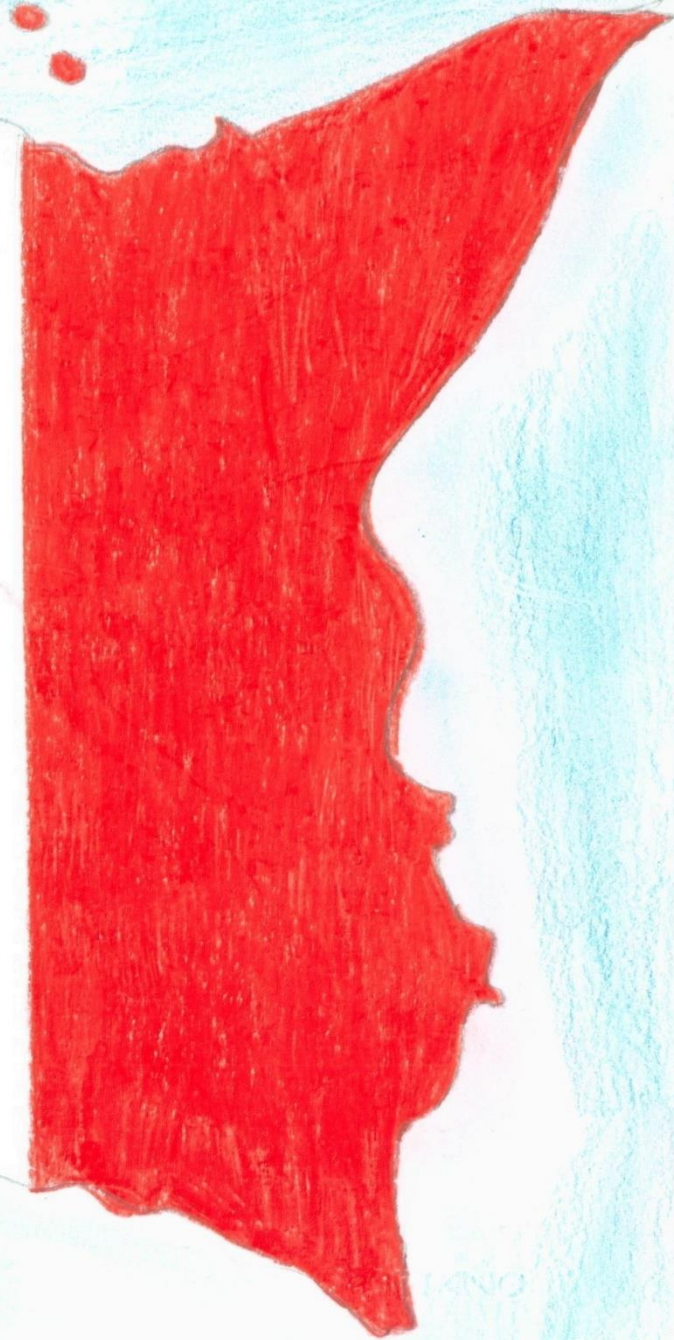
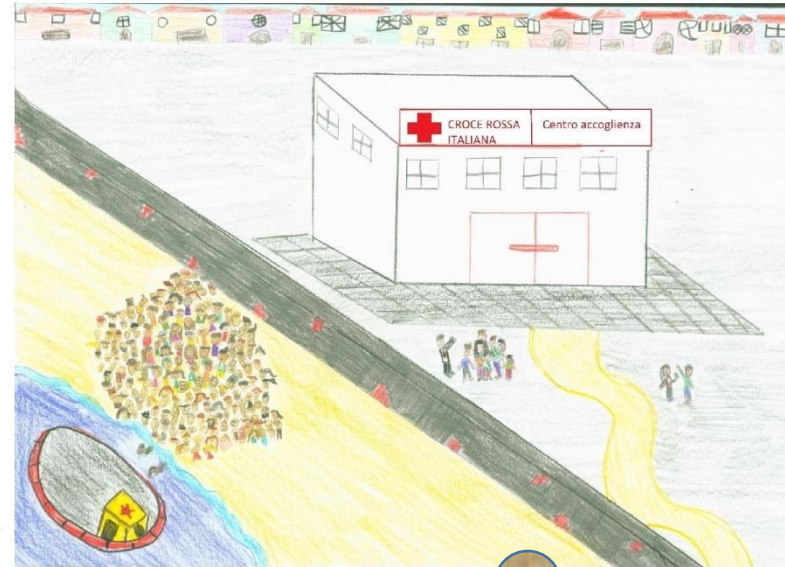

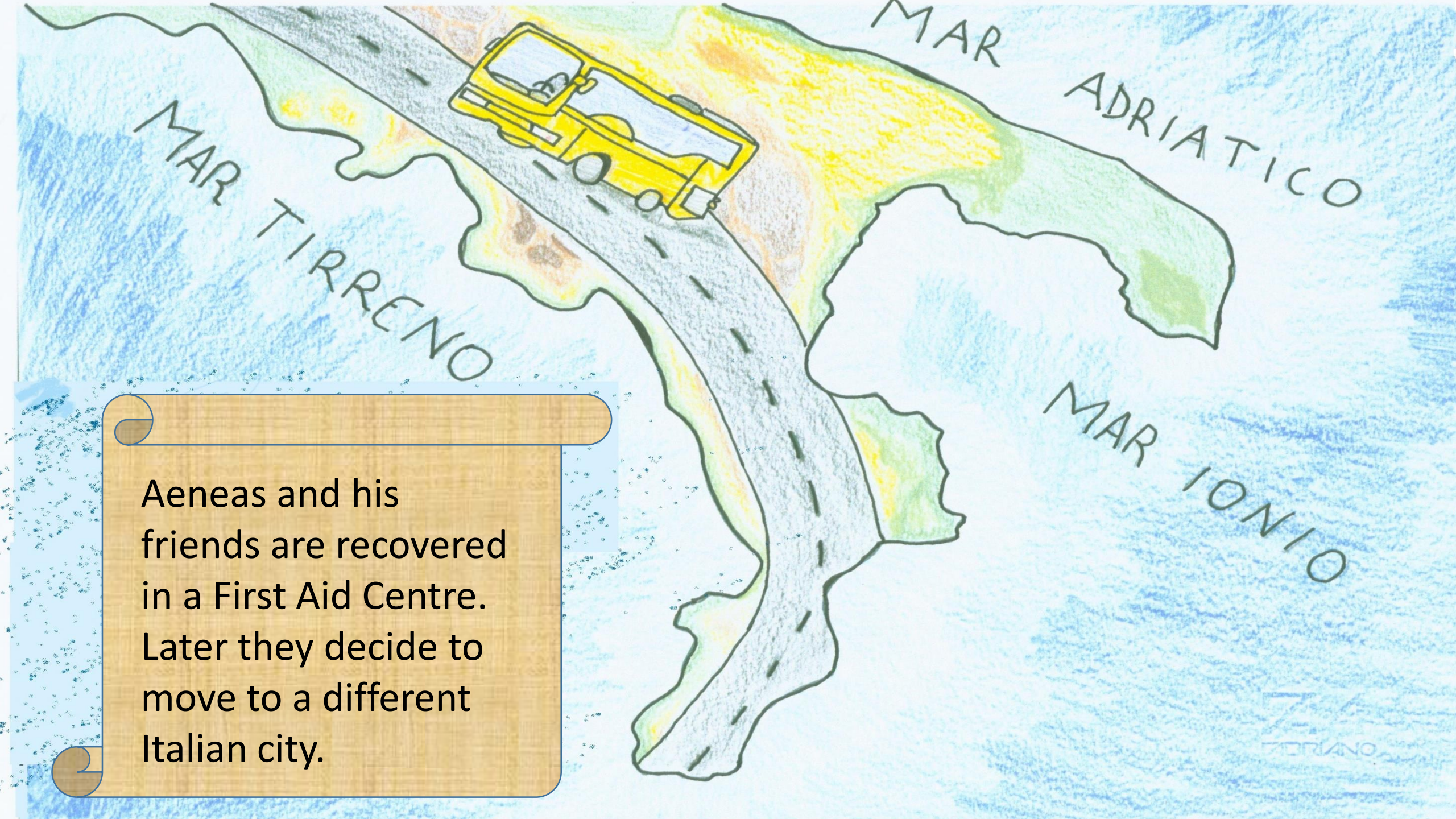
