Summary:

Enel is an Italian multinational company, producer and distributor of electricity and gas. It was established as a public body in late 1962, in 1992 it was transformed into a company by shares. In 1999, after the liberalization of the electricity market was privatized. The Italian State still retains the position of principal shareholder and in May of 2015 held 25.5% of the share capital.

Enel's first objectives were the modernization and development of the electricity grid with the construction of the high-voltage electric lines, electrification of rural areas and the completion of the national electricity grid supply centre. These activities were also financed by the issuance, in 1965, of bonds guaranteed by the state worth more than 200 billion Italian Money.

Globally, the Enel group covers the following areas and activities:

Production, distribution and sale of electricity and gas in the Iberian Peninsula, Latin America and Morocco, through Enel Ibero-America and the subsidiaries Endesa and Enersis and in Russia through the subsidiary Enel Russia.

Generation of electricity from renewable sources globally (North America, South America, Africa, Europe and Asia) via Enel Green Power.

It operates in the gas sector and is present in North Africa in Egypt.

Carries out financial fundraising activities in the markets, employing them in investment operations through its subsidiaries.
