·Summary:

The Allianz Group is a German multinational financial services company based in Munich. It is one of the most important insurance groups and financial service providers in the world. Its revenue amounted to more than 106.4 billion euros in 2012. Michael Diekmann has been the Chief Executive Officer since April 29, 2003 and successor to Chairman of the Supervisory Board Henning Schulte-Noelle who served from 1991 to 2003.

Since 2005, the annual remuneration of the Board and the Supervisory Council is designated individually together with the published annual report. Created in 1890, the group is present in more than 70 countries on five continents, where 144,000 employees of different nationality, language, religion, training and experience serve more than 78 million clients.

In 1906 Allianz made its first major payout to clients, as they had to face payments from the devastating San Francisco earthquake. In April 1912, when the Titanic hit an iceberg, Allianz also faced the policy payments.

The insurance covers civil liability, windows, theft, fire, and additionally includes protection against own damages. The policy also has all the advantages of its extensive travel assistance and the possibility of additional services such as the replacement vehicle.
