



My working plan was not fully planned, but I did it one day per week. At first I did not understand what to do, but after first week everything was fine.










Individual strategic Giovanni

During the period December 2020 to February 2021, members of team I had the chance to study upon the subject of "Maths and Finance" as a part of the Erasmus+ project "Maths everywhere". The team members, one of each participating country, had to study and do virtual investments in a various of companies which belonged to Eurostoxx50.

This activity took place with the participation of all members in a virtual game of buying and selling shareholders.

Within 4 weeks, from January 4th to January 29th, 2021, all team members had to make 3-10 transaction according to the game rules that had been given them by the teachers.





The companies were grouped together and each student invested in companies of his/her choice.

The **average number** of companies invested was 5 as the highest volume was given by the student from Spain with 8 companies and the lowest volume with 3 companies by the student from Greece.

In addition, the student from Latvia invested in 7 companies, student from Turkey in 5 companies and student from Italy in 4 companies. Each company group had a list of 10 companies.





During the activity some companies made profits and some did not.

According students, the work was very useful and informative and they have learned many new thing about investing and stocks. Most of them preferred investing in companies they trusted.

They tried to find out the companies they wanted to invest in by searching their past financial activity.

All students mentioned that the reason these companies were chosen was because they were considered top in Europe and worldwide.

According that it was easy to them study the prices that companies had a year ago, in December 2019- January 2020 before the pandemic broke out and it was seen that the prices were high enough, according to this year which they apparently were affected by COVID-19
