### Review

Eni was founded in 1953 from Agip, an already existing company. Agip was founded in 1926, with the purpose to explore oilfields and commercialize oil and derivatives.



Eni was originally an acronym for the company's full title Ente Nazionale Idrocarburi (National Hydrocarbons Authority). After 1995, the meaning has lost importance but the name was kept. In 1952, the logo of Eni was selected: It is a six-legged dog, symbolizing the sum of a car's four wheels and the two legs of its driver. Since 2007, Eni has been included into the Dow Jones Sustainability World Index.

Eni now operates in 66 countries and has sold 73,07 billion m<sup>3</sup> gas worldwide (2019). The current Chairman of the Board is Lucia Calvosa; current Chief Executive Officer is Claudio Descalzi.
