The deutsche post AG operating under the trade name Deutsche post DHL group is a german multinational package delivery and supply chain management company headquartered in Bonn, Germany. It is the world's largest courier company, operating in over 220 countries.

The company was born from the succession of the Deutsche Bundespost as a public company, owned by the german government, became private only in 1995, and then a fully independent company in 2000, traded as the Frankfurt stock exchange.

Since its privatization, Deutsche post widely expanded its operating area through acquisitions and consequently assets became higher too.

It incorporated the DHL package and delivery group as a wholly owned subsidiary, and in 2014, it has incorporated the Street Scooter GmbH, and later the UK Mail too, becoming a division of the Deutsche Post European parcel network.

Deutsche Post AG is listed on the Börse Frankfurt (Frankfurt Stock Exchange) as DPW and is in the Euro Stoxx 50 stock market index. In 2016, 20.5% of the group's shares were held by the state-owned KfW bank; for 65.6% held by institutional and 10.8% by private investors
