Safran is an international high-technology group, operating in aviation defense and space markets. It was formed by a merger between the aircraft and rocket engine manufacturer and aerospace component manufacturer group SNECMA and the security company SAGEM in 2005. In 2018 Safran took control of Zodiac Aerospace, significantly expanding its aircraft equipment activities. Safran has a global presence alone or in partnership, world or regional leadership positions in its core markets. Safran undertakes research and development programs to maintain the environmental priorities of its R&T and Innovation roadmap.

Safran is listed on NYSE Euronext Paris. Its share is part of the French stock market index, CAC 40 and of the European market index, Euro Stoxx 50.
