SUMMARY: The Air Liquide Group was founded in 1902 on the initiative of Paul Delorme and the inventor of the air liquefaction process, Georges Claude, and soon established branches and companies in Europe and other continents, creating the first multinational group in the technical gas sector and medicines: 135 branches in over 80 countries around the world that employ approximately 67,000 employees (after the acquisition of the American company Airgas in May 2016) serving 3 million customers.

Air Liquide is a joint stock company listed on the CAC 40 in Paris, the city where it is based.
