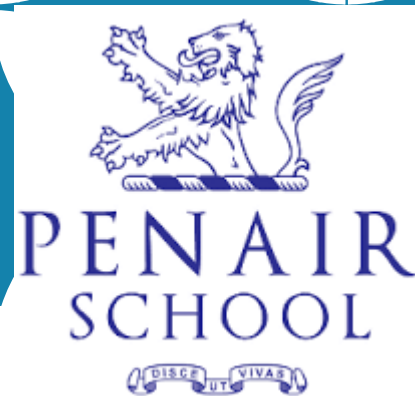


Diversity at Penair

In maths, his teacher spotted that he was slower.

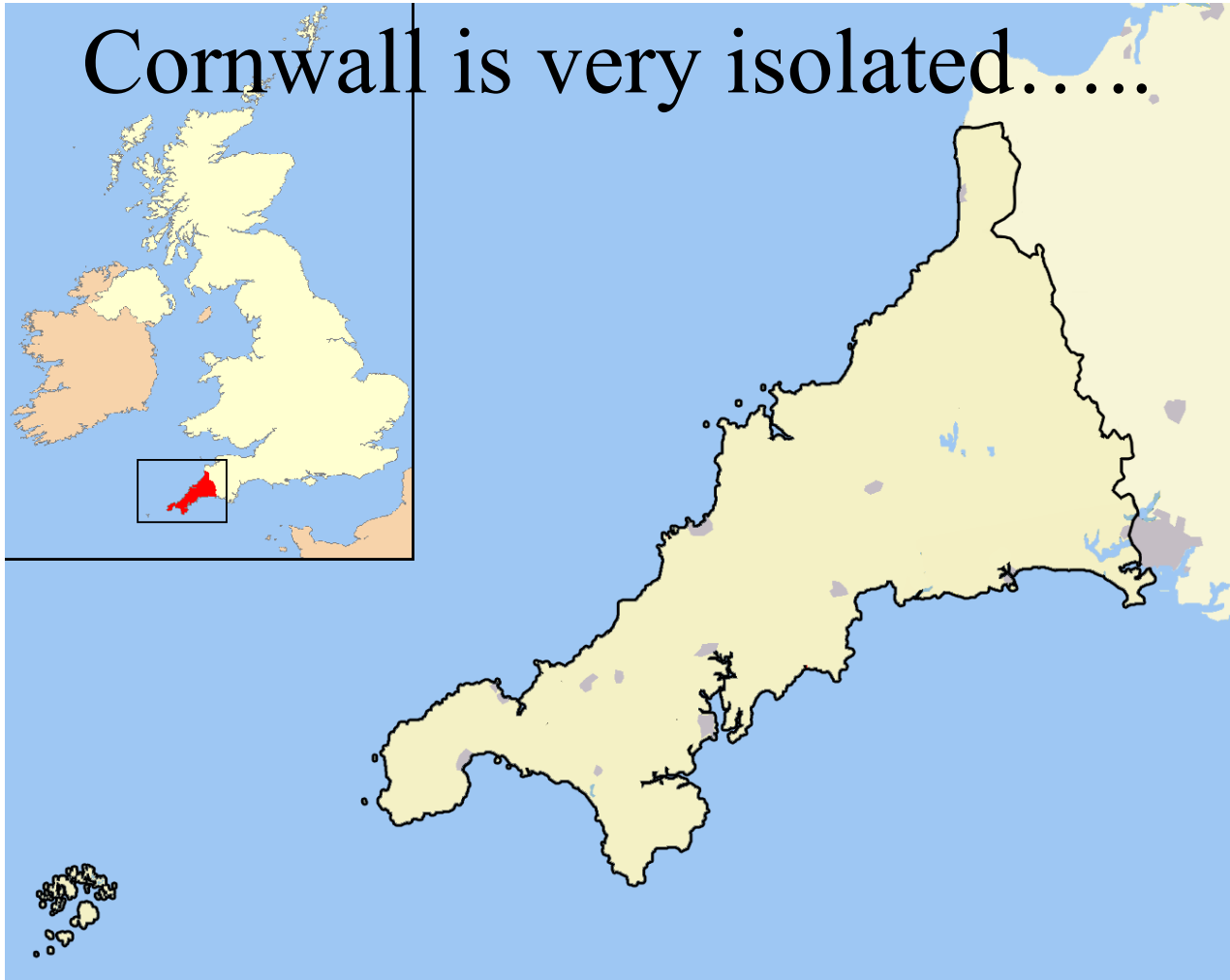
However, he's top set for maths. So he wasn't accomplishing as much as he could.
