In what ways were the prisoners being brought to Jasenovac?

Find the photograph «At the Entrance to the Camp», showing a man who had just been brought to the camp.

- What is happening in the photograph?

The man is removing his rings? and probably other belongings. Despair, the soldier distance/ignorance)

- What emotions can you see on his face?

Find the screen with the photographs of children separated from their parents. What emotions can you see on their faces?

Apathy

Find the exhibited shackles. What do they tell us about the treatment of inmates?

Find the photograph of children in the attic of the Tower in Stara Gradiška camp.

- What do these children look like?

skinny, starved, resigned

- What does the room they are in look like?

empty, cold

- What conclusion can we draw from that about the way the Ustasha took care of the children in the camp?

Visible, outcast

Find the exhibited signs, made of cloth and metal, with the Jewish symbol. What was its purpose? Try to imagine the emotions of a person who had to wear such a sign.

Find the exhibited metal plate with the sign «NO WATER», used when inmates were not being given water as punishment or as a method of execution. What do you think about the use of thirst as a method of torture?

Explain the meaning of the word *dehumanisation*.
