Susan Jocelyn Bell Burnell born in Belfast as Susan Joecelyn Bell, July 15, 1943 is a Northern Irish astrophysicist. She is one of the most influential scientists in the UK and has received numerous awards. She worked at the University of Southampton between 1968 and 1973, at University College London from 1974 to 1982 and at The Royal Observatory of Edinburgh (1982-1991).
