WOMEN OF LITERATURE

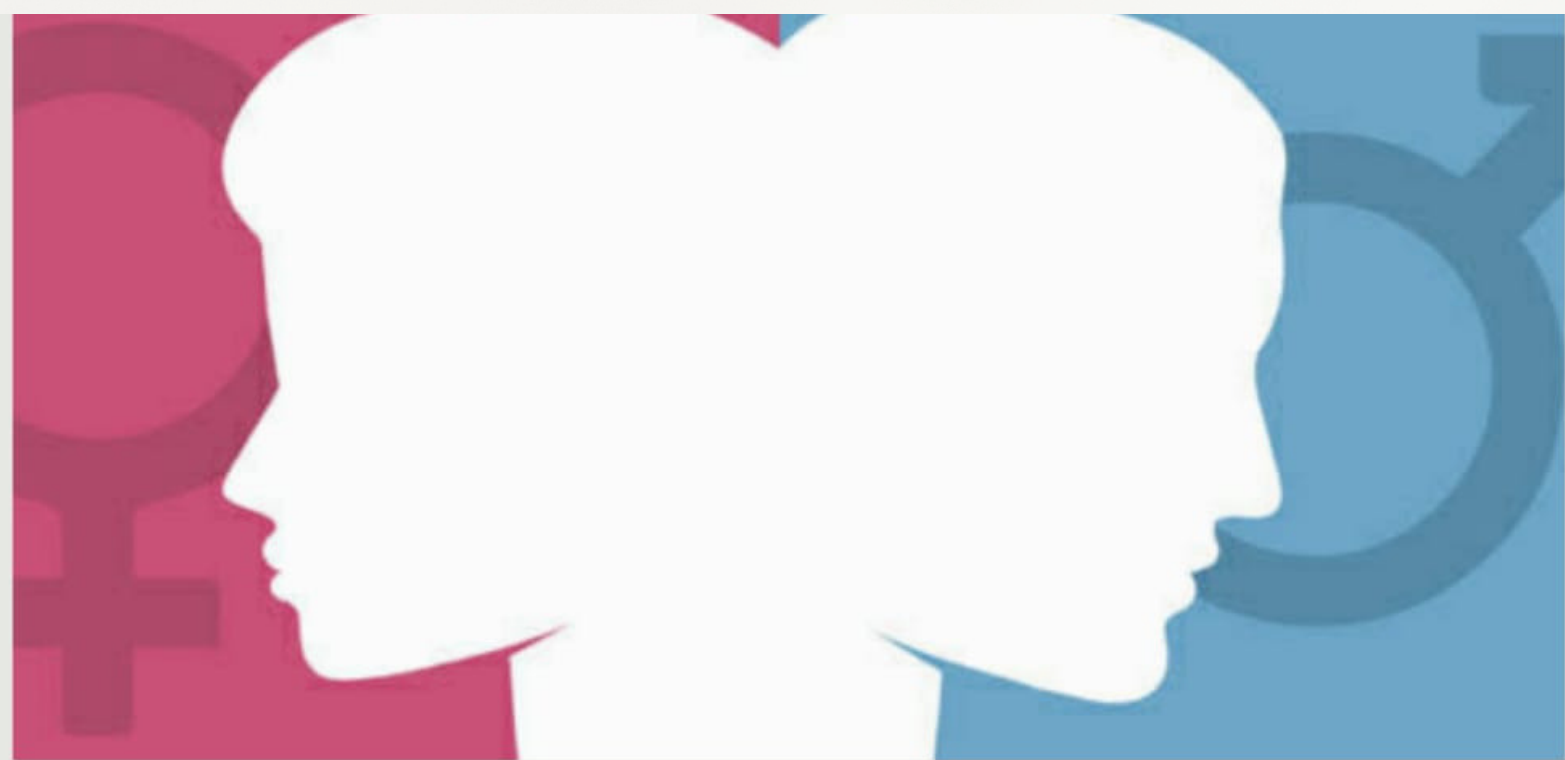

GENDER ROLES IN SOCIAL MEDIA

WE THOUGHT THAT WOMEN HAD MORE PARTS IN THE MEDIA AND DECIDED TO MAKE A SURVEY WHICH CONFIRMED OUR THOUGHT. WE ASKED A QUESTION TO 100 GIRLS IN OUR SCHOOL. THE HALF OF THE ANSWERS WE GET REVEALED THAT WOMEN ARE CUTIOUS ABOUT THE POSTS THAT OTHER WOMEN SHARED. AND THE OTHER HALF SHOW THAT WOMEN LIKE VANITY MORE ; FOLLOW FASHION MAKE-UP POSTS AND SUCH AFTER WE ASKED THE FIRST QUESTION , WE ASKED ABOUT 100 MEN WHY MEN USED SOCIAL MEDIA SO MUCH . THE ANSWERS WE RECEIVED WERE GENERALLY ABOUT THE SAME. THEY WERE CHATTING WITH GIRLS ; FOLLOWING GAME PAGES , RECENT EVENTS AND NEWS ; WATCHING RE - RUNS OF SOCCER / FOOTBALL GAMES. ACCORDING TO THESE RESULTS ; WOMEN USE SOCIAL MEDIA TO MAKE THEIR VOICES HEARD AND TO HAVE SELF-CONFIDENCE. THE REASON WHY MEN USE SOCIAL MEDIA LESS THAN WOMEN IS THEY CAN MAKE THEIR VOICES HEARD IN EVERY OCCASION POSSIBLE AND THEY HAVE ENOUGH CONFIDENCE OF THEIR OWN.
