Primary School No. 6 is the oldest school of its kind in Gniezno. Its construction was completed in 1915. Until 1921 the school building served as a military hospital.

When II War broke out in 1939 and the Germans entered Gniezno, the School was closed and the teacher was deported.

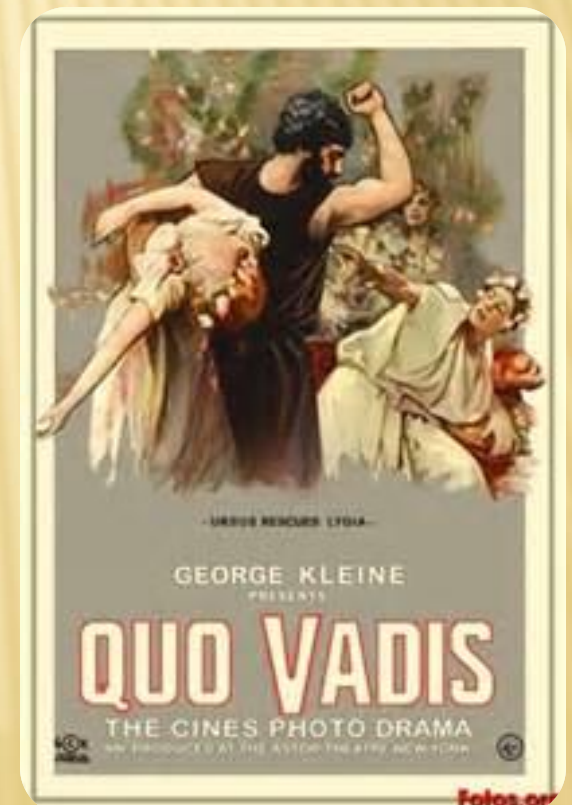
Students returned to school in 1945.
