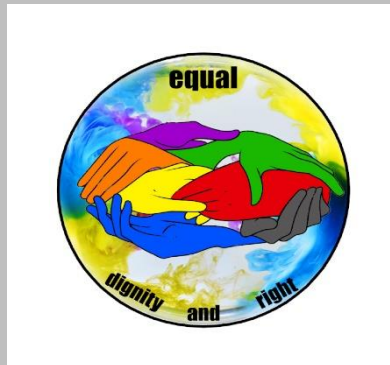

Literature, ancient and modern Greek language and history teacher, Drama Educator, initiative in playwright actions, member and present President of the Board of the Network.

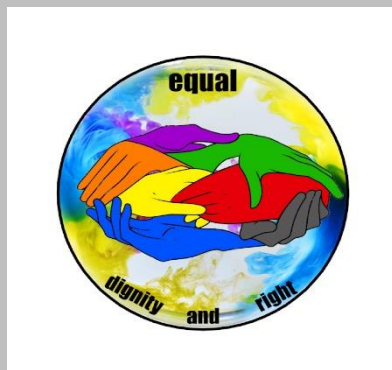
❖ Duration: Two workshops, each of a two-hour length
