01 ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Recognize different types of accommodation
- Promote the ability to work as a team and improve the ability to act independently.
- Develop ICT and English language skills as well as soft skills like collaborative and interpersonal skills, communication and critical thinking skills.
- Improve decision-making and problem solving through interaction with others.







07 ONLINE MEETINGS

This project had many kind of online meetings. The project started with teachers online meeting in the beginning of January. Optional online meeting with partners was arranged mainly bilateral. In the beginning of February arranged Kahoot online meeting. At the end of project arranged dissemination event.



01 — Teachers online meeting

Teachers online meeting was arranged before the project started. Teachers learn to know each other, they were talked about project tasks, tools and schedules. This team was working the first time together, so it was important to know working methods in the project.



02 — Bilateral online meetings

Optional task was the bilateral online meetings with partners. We created a page where partners planned the meetings. The biggest problem for online meetings was the schedules. Online meeting with all students arranged by Spanish team where students participated Kahoot which questions has been selected from posters students have made about the tourist attractions.








Feedback for students made in Mentimeter and Google forms.












Most of students think that the project exciting and amazing. About 75 % of students answered that this project increased their awareness of interntional consciousness (agree or strongly agree). The most entertaining activities were Kahoot and poster.







When asked according to the tourist attraction posters, students wanted to travel all partner countries. The most popular were Greece and Finland

Students learned many new web 2.0 tools in this project like Canva, Face.co, Genial.ly, vocaroo, pixton and Bookcreator

64,5 % of students have widened their intercultural dimension in this project.
Also 29 % have partly widened it.
71 % want to join another eTwinning project later as well as 25 % maybe want to join.



Most of teachers thought that planning the project, finding partners to project, teachers' cooperation were good, very good or excellent.




